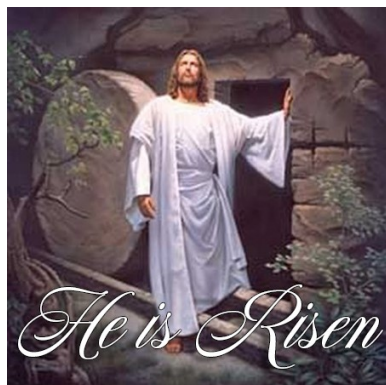

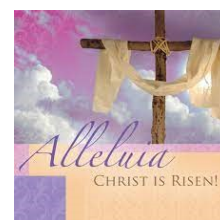

**Communion on the hand is preferred.** If you want to receive communion on the tongue, please wait until the end of the communion line.

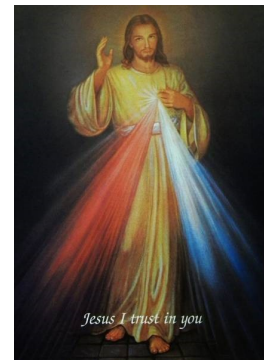

Evelyn Waugh regarded *Brideshead Revisited* as his masterpiece. Published during the war, his reputation by this stage had been well established. It is a book about divine grace, the shallowness of modernity, love, infidelity, art and architecture and of course war. In other words, a novel for today. Brideshead castle, with 'a twitch upon a thread' draws the various characters into it's orbit. It is the church displaced to the English countryside. It is easy to see that during the bleakness of war, Brideshead stands in for the "heavenly chariot flying through the ages...the wild truth reeling but erect", as Chesterton might have put it. Set in a time when people wrote letters and ate anchovy toast and Fuller's walnut cake at picnics, come and join us in discussing Waugh's splendid masterpiece.

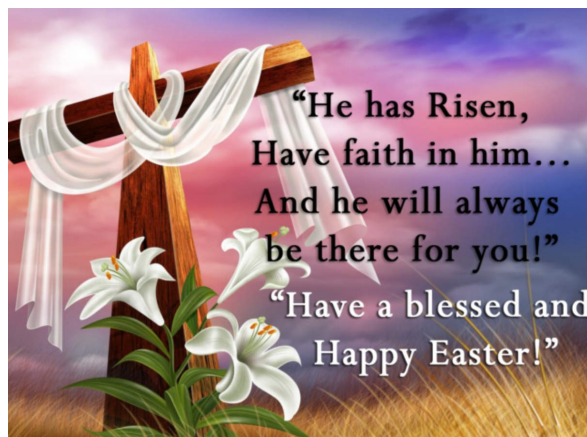

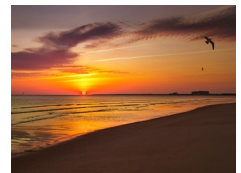
