From Fr Vince

On 30 June I will be leaving Terrigal Parish, retiring from the administrative duties of Parish Priest, to be available for another ministry. Let me explain what has happened.

Last year I spoke with Bishop Anthony, requesting that when my appointment at Terrigal concludes I would like to begin a sacramental ministry to those who no longer go to Mass, but still approach the church for the sacraments. These people can have particular needs and, belonging nowhere, sometimes find it difficult to connect with a priest, and are often lost to the church. I want to be available to celebrate the sacraments for them, so they know that they belong with us.

Bishop Anthony agreed to support me in this ministry, and before he leaves for Rome, has proposed that I retire from parish duties on 30 June 2026.

This is all very sudden, and I appreciate that it might be a bit unsettling for some people. It also means change for me and I am making plans for the future. I will communicate these arrangements with you when I know what is happening. We don't know yet what arrangements are being made for the parish. Again, we will communicate these with you when we know them.

Change is always difficult. I have loved being your Parish Priest and am sad to be leaving the parish. Yet, I am convinced that this is part of the Lord's plan and am open to all that might come with this new ministry.

I thank everyone for your affirmation and support for me and for this new venture.

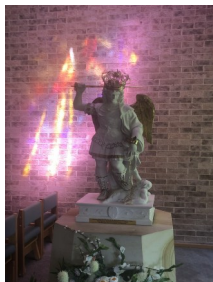

Bookclub

“The God who comes to us in Jesus Christ, who lifts us up beyond ourselves and moves us to salvation, the God of ecstatic self offering, the God whose outreach of love is greater than we can think or imagine, is very strange. That, writes Bishop Barron in his book on **Thomas Aquinas**, is a valid one sentence summary of Thomas Aquinas’ doctrine of God. What Thomas endeavours to say in his hundreds of pages on God, is really quite simple: God is uncanny. The simple God is the God, who cannot be understood or controlled; the good God is the one who captivates us, and draws us out of ourselves; the God, who is present to the world is the divine power that will never leave us alone, that insinuates itself into our blood and bones; the eternal, God is the one who invites us into the ecstasy of being beyond time; the immutable God is the rock in which we can build our lives; the God of knowledge and love, is the spirit who searches us, and knows us, who seeks us and who would never abandon us, this is the God **Thomas Aquinas**, seeks to celebrate. Join us for this discussion. In June we will be reading the book- **Pilgrimage to the Museum: Man’s Search for God through Art and Time** by Stephen F. Auth. Art attracts people to faith and this is a beautiful book which is essentially a tour through the Metropolitan Museum. In July we will be discussing one of Chesterton’s most loved books: *The Man Who Was Thursday- a Nightmare*.
