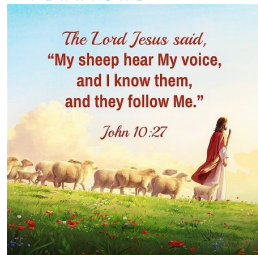

## Let Us Pray

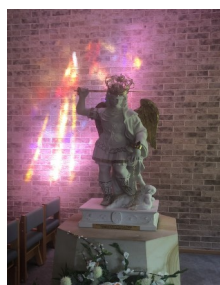

## Bookclub

Shusaku Endo is a well known Japanese author who wrote about the relationship between East and West through a Christian perspective. He describes his Christian baptism while embedded in Buddhist Japan as an “arranged marriage.” He studied French literature at uni and was influenced by writers such as Mauriac and Bernanos and especially Graham Greene. This month our book club will be reading one of his most widely read novels *Deep River*. A novel about a group of pilgrims to the Ganges river. Endo is a great story teller and it is easy to see why he might have been recommended for the Nobel prize.



**In September** we will be reading Corrie ten Boom's recollections of hiding Jewish families during the occupation of The Netherlands- *The Hiding Place*.

**In October** we will be reading *Song at the Scaffold* by Gertrude von Le Fort. Set during the French Revolution, when madness was thick in the air, this short novel is based on a true story of the Carmelite nuns of Compiègne, who offered their lives for the preservation of the Church in France.

The privilege and responsibility of a spiritual director is to journey with you, in one-on-one conversations, as you deepen your relationship with God. What is shared is held in confidence.


## Australian Catholic Historical Society
