Through the Desert God Leads us to Freedom

is a simple Lenten resource prepared by Fr Kenneth Hagen based on Pope Francis' Message for Lent 2024. It is just one page, with one question for your reflection each week of Lent. *Copies are available at the door of the church.*

In his message the Pope invites all Christians to reflect on ways by which we can leave the "desert" of the present time and discover the "freedom" which God offers his people.

Question One: What traditions in the Church, Nation, and my personal life limit me in serving others?

Preparing for Easter

The 40 days of Lent are our time of reflection and penance. They prepare us for the greatest event in human history – the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead. This is the foundation of our faith. As St Paul put it, “if Christ be not risen then we witness in vain.” (1 Corinthians 15:14).

But what is the resurrection? What is the story behind it?

How do all the Gospel accounts form a complete picture?

And why are the accounts so brief about the 40 days between the resurrection and the ascension?

What is the role of women in the resurrection?

Why is it so significant?

As part of our Lenten preparation, we will be exploring these questions on **Thursday 29th February at 7pm in the Parish Office.**

In a second session, later in Lent we will explore other themes relating to Easter:

The last judgement. What will happen? What do we know about it?

Why do the Jehovah Witnesses say only 144,000 people can go to heaven?

Why do so many Christian denominations believe there will be a 1,000-year reign of Christ on earth?

Explore our faith. Understand the message of Christ. **Come along.** No need to register. Christ himself said: “you shall learn the truth and the truth will make you free.” (John 8:31).

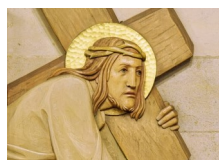

"The Season of Lent is a most important time of preparation for the celebration of Easter we are drawn more deeply into the mystery of the life, death, and resurrection of Jesus.

The Season of Lent commences on Ash Wednesday Marking our foreheads with ashes in the sign of the cross on Ash Wednesday is an outward sign of internal conversion. It is also an invitation to "Turn away from sin and believe the good news" we acknowledge our human vulnerability, and we pray to be strengthened by God's grace, mercy, and love.

On Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, abstinence from meat is to be observed by those who have completed their fourteenth year of age. Those who are aged between 18 and 60 are to fast on these days.

On all other Fridays of Lent the law of the common practice of penance is fulfilled by prayer, self-denial or helping others.

Each of the faithful is obliged to receive Holy Communion at least once a year. This is done between Ash Wednesday and Trinity Sunday (26th May). All the faithful are obliged to confess their grave sins at least once a year."
