Church in the Café from the PPC

A new idea? No, it's been around for a while. It's a simple concept that every so often we all meet together in a more informal atmosphere for divine worship. We have some excellent proposals for a musical presentation and would follow up by reading the story of the Ascension and discussing it.

Are you interested? Then save the date. One of the great mysteries of our faith is the 40 days that Christ spent on earth after his Resurrection culminating in his glorious Ascension. Something we celebrate but rarely actually discuss.
