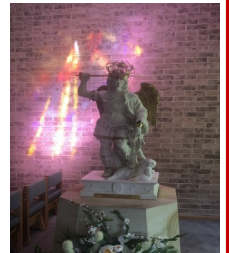

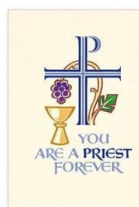

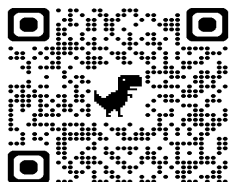

## Introduction to Pastoral Care Course

The *Introduction to Pastoral Care Course* (IPCC) meets this requirement, is **FREE** and is open to those who already volunteer in a hospital context, or in local health and aged care facilities, and to those who might be deciding if they are suited to this ministry.

As well as being prepared by your Parish to be an Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion, some of the key qualities we are looking for in anyone who may be considering being part of this hospital ministry are:

- A genuine prayerful faith life including reverence for and regular participation in Sunday Eucharist
- An ability to listen and a willingness to refer on when necessary
- A warm, friendly, empathetic disposition
- The ability to relate to people of different ages, personalities and backgrounds
- A respect for others and their diversity
- The ability to work as part of a team
- Enthusiasm, motivation and professionalism
- A compassionate heart

## Bookclub

**Mere Christianity** written by C S Lewis began life as a series of talks on the BBC during the war. Lewis decided that he wanted to talk about the Law of Nature, or objective right and wrong. At the time, the talks were immensely popular and the four talks were eventually collected and published as a book **Mere Christianity** which will be discussed at our next book club meeting on Friday 24<sup>th</sup> April at 1600 in the parish office. "The author shows himself a master in the rare art of conveying profound truths in simple and compelling language," wrote G.D Smith in the Clergy Review at the time. "He approaches you directly, as a rational person only to be persuaded by reason", wrote The Guardian.

In May we will read Bishop Robert Barron's little book on **Saint Thomas Aquinas**. Published by Word on Fire, Aquinas is, along with St Augustine, one of the most prominent theologians in the catholic faith. Theology is not an academic exercise but a matter of spiritual life or death, and so Bishop Barron reminds us that at the core of Aquinas' writing is a deep love of the Lord.

In June we will be reading the book - **Pilgrimage to the Museum: Man's Search for God through Art and Time** by Stephen F Auth. Art attracts people to faith and this is a beautiful book which is essentially a tour through the Metropolitan Museum.
