





Giving in the Parish

We have **two regular collections** in the parish each weekend.

The First Collection goes to a common fund (Pastoral Revenue) across all diocesan parishes and is used to support the Bishop and all the priests (active and retired) in the Diocese. Donations for Baptisms, Weddings, Funerals and Easter and Christmas offerings go to the Pastoral Revenue.

The Second Collection goes to our Church Account and stays in the parish and is used to meet all our expenses. Rents, planned giving, regular direct debits and other donations (unless explicitly directed elsewhere) go to the Church Account. Donations through *Tap 'n' Go* in the church and *Donate Now* on our website go to the Church Account.

Funds from the account built, and are now used to maintain the church, hall, offices, presbytery and grounds. They pay for all our running costs including insurance, employment and office, church and pastoral expenses.

All other **special collections** go to the charity or activity advertised when we have the appeal.

Bookclub

Next Friday our book club will meet to discuss Dr Brant Pitre's book "Jesus and the Jewish Roots of the Eucharist." Pitre reminds us that to understand what is going on at mass it helps to understand the Jewish context of the Last Supper. Jesus drew directly on the Jewish Scriptures in the Old Testament. According to ancient Jewish tradition, the Messiah was expected to come during the feast of Passover. At the Last Supper, Jesus instituted a new Passover in which He revealed Himself to be the true Passover lamb. Exodus then is a fairly pivotal event in understanding the Eucharist. We are also reminded that manna was viewed as miraculous "bread from heaven", and Jesus spoke of the coming of the new manna from heaven and identifies it with the Eucharist. Pitre's book is an interesting reminder that our current mass has roots that go back generations and generations, back even to the bread and wine offered by the priest Melchizedek.

If the subject matter interest you please join us next Friday 25th at 1600 in parish offices

In August we will read Shusaku Endo's 1993 novel Deep River about four Japanese tourists on a pilgrimage to the Ganges in India in search of spiritual discoveries. Many may be more familiar with his book "Silence" which has been made into a film by Martin Scorsese.

In September we will be reading Corrie ten Boom's recollections of hiding Jewish families during the occupation of The Netherlands-The Hiding Place.

Our book club meets on the last Friday of every month at 1600 hrs in the parish offices.


