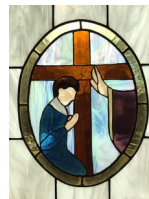

Recently two parishioners alerted me to my name being used in a scam.

They received a text message:

*"Hello, this is Fr. Vince Casey, I'm in a meeting right now, can't talk on the phone but text me back when you get this message, your assistance is crucial and highly appreciated. Blessings."*

When one texted back – a risky move – she received this response:

*"Thanks for texting back. I would have called but can't talk right now because I'm in a meeting and it's going to take a while before I'm done. I need to get Amazon gift cards. I promised a cancer patient for her birthday, but I can't do that right now. Can you quickly get it from any store around you."*

Clearly a scam!

They both rang me to let me know. Thank-you. No-one from the parish would text or email you with a request for money or gift cards. If you are not sure (and sometimes scammers are very good) ring the parish office number (43674610) and speak with someone to check with us.
