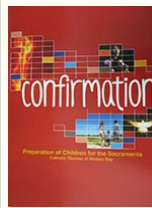

## CONFIRMATION 2024

The Sacrament of Confirmation is offered to baptised children in Year 3 and older. Confirmation is usually the next Sacrament after Baptism, and before Reconciliation and Holy Communion.



### STEP 1: ENROLMENT

Enrolments will be accepted at the Parish Office over the holidays. **The last days for enrolment** will take place at the church after the Masses on the :

Saturday 27<sup>th</sup> April at 5.00pm,

Sunday 28<sup>th</sup> April at 7.30am & 9.30am

Please Bring your completed enrolment form and a copy of your child's Baptism certificate (if not Baptised at Terrigal), plus \$25.00 to cover the cost of the activity book, certificate etc.

### STEP 2: INPUT SESSION FOR PARENTS

This session will be held in the church at on **Wednesday 1<sup>st</sup> May at 7pm.**

Please arrive at 6.45pm so we can distribute the resources. We aim to make this a relaxed, spiritual, informative evening. We will finish by 8pm.

It is essential that at least one parent comes to this session. If there is some serious reason you are unable to attend, please let Fr Vince or Janette know through the Parish Office.

### STEP 4: PARISH PRESENTATIONS

Children receiving Confirmation will be presented to the Parish at all the Masses over this weekend. Mass times are Saturday 18<sup>th</sup> May at 5.00pm, or Sunday 19<sup>th</sup> May at 7.30am and 9.30am

### STEP 5: CONFIRMATION DAY

## ANZAC Day Thursday 25th

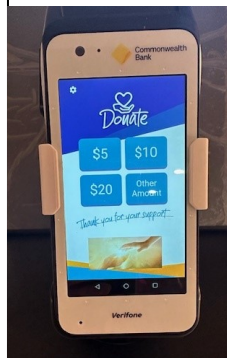


Mass in our Parish is at 9am to pray for those who gave their lives in service and for those who fought to give us peace.

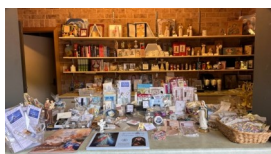

## What is spiritual direction?

In spiritual direction you reflect deeply on the experiences of your daily life, your loves, hurts, dreams, joys and fears.

Gradually, as you contemplate, you may begin to discover how God's spirit is moving in your life and that God has been waiting for you to see this closer relationship.

Spiritual direction is really not about being directed, nor is it therapy, or counselling. Rather, it is very much about being encouraged to draw closer to God whether that be in your prayer life, relationships, in nature, or in the events of your life. The privilege and responsibility of a spiritual director is to journey with you, in one-on-one conversations, as you deepen your relationship with God. What is shared is held in confidence.

A meeting time is agreed upon, usually once a month, for an hour.

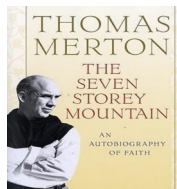

It talks of four types of dignity - ontological, moral, social and existential - and notes that "there is an ever-growing risk of reducing human dignity" and identifies thirteen "grave violations".

## Some reminders to ministers

During the celebration of Mass, including the **processions** at the beginning and end of Mass, everyone bows to the altar. We do not bow or genuflect to the tabernacle during Mass, but the tradition continues to genuflect to the tabernacle when we enter and leave the church.

**Collectors** are asked to begin the first collection as soon as we sit after the Prayers of the Faithful. The exception is the collector in the middle aisle, who is asked to wait until after the offertory procession. The second collection begins as soon as the distribution of communion finishes – do not wait till the tabernacle has been closed to begin.

**Communion Ministers** are asked to come on to the sanctuary during the Lamb of God, to sanitise the hands and be ready to receive and distribute a Holy Communion. When you have finished, return the ciborium to the altar and return to your seat – do not wait on the sanctuary till the tabernacle has been closed.

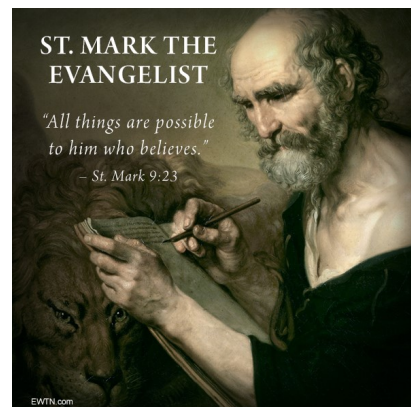
