Ascension Day - Church in the café

This week the parish celebrated for the first time the Ascension of Our Lord with an innovative form of service – church in the cafe. 35 parishioners attended and we were joined by Father Mark Watson from the Anglican Church of the Holy Trinity and a number of his congregation. It was a great success. Garry and Gerry organised both the service and the catering. Appreciation to them both for a first-class job.

The service consisted of inspirational music followed by scripture reading then video presentations on the Ascension, group discussion, more inspirational music and an excellent morning tea. Participants were seated at tables and were free to move around and help themselves. Fr Vince opened with prayer; the concluding prayer and benediction were given by Fr Mark.. As a church we need to look at new forms of worship in addition to the holy sacrifice of the Mass. The Mass remains the core of all liturgical devotion but new times call for new innovations to supplement.

Inspired by the Holy Father, Pope Francis, earlier this year taking with him the Archbishop of Canterbury to South Sudan, our parish needs also to work more with our Anglican brothers. Hopefully this service is our small contribution to both new liturgical approaches and to the development of ongoing ecumenical relations.

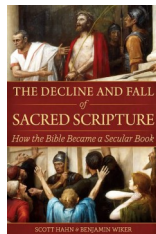
