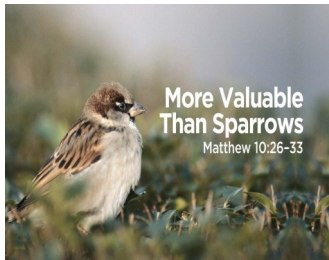

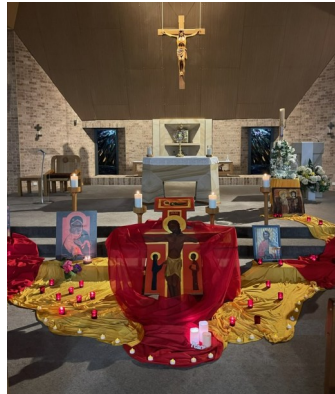

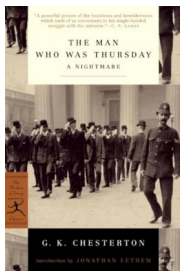

Chesterton once commented that at the back of our brains is a blaze of astonishment at our own existence. The object of artistic and spiritual life is to dig for this sunrise of wonder. Art is born when the temporary touches the eternal. Much the same can be said about literature. Our book club this month will be discussing Stephen F Auth's book which forms the basis of a pilgrimage through the metropolitan art museum in New York. Masterpieces by some of the greatest artists remind us that the search for that sunrise of wonder is never ending. In July we will be discussing one of Chesterton's most loved books: *The Man Who Was Thursday - a Nightmare*. A metaphysical thriller that involves seven anarchists in turn of the century London who are represented by days of the week. A critique of moral relativism and nihilism.

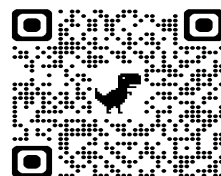
