

Pastoral Letter

"The Mystery of Faith: Encountering Jesus Christ in the Eucharist" by Bishop Anthony is available at the doors of the church. Topics include:

- 1. The mystery
- 2. Jesus is truly present
- 3. This presence endures
- 4. Communion is the heart of the Mass
- 5. Communion forgives their sins; seek Reconciliation regularly
- 6. Sing and receive communion reverently
- 7. On the hand or on the tongue
- 8. Under both kinds from November 2025. Senior service may want to read No.4 which explains why we should receive hosts consecrated at this Mass.

There are clear instructions on how to receive the host (No. 7) and from the chalice (No.8).

Bookclub

Corrie ten Boom's father owned a watch and clocks repair shop in Haarlem Holland. Next door was the opticians' shop, while across the road was the dress shop, the baker's and Weil's Furrier.



Each week her father would travel to Amsterdam to get the Naval Observatory Time to set his clocks accordingly. Then along came the radio. He resisted this new technology for a while but was curious when on every hour the BBC would chime the Big Ben. He remained distrustful of English time as he knew several Englishmen and they were invariably late. But he noticed that Big Ben and the Observatory more often than not were in perfect agreement. And over a period, the astronomical time became inaccurate when the jarring and jiggling of traffic affected its precision. As Corrie writes: "The ultimate ignominy came the day Father set the astronomical clock by the radio.

Corrie ten Boom hid Jewish families during the war and The Hiding Place is the book we will be discussing at our next book club meeting on Friday 26th September at 1600 in the parish offices.

In October we will be reading Song at the Scaffold by Gertrude von Le Fort. Set during the French Revolution, when madness was thick in the air, this short novel is based on a true story of the Carmelite nuns of Compiègne, who offered their lives for the preservation of the Church in France

November will be the last meeting for the year and this has traditionally been a "freestyle" meeting when each brings some inspirational piece of writing poem or piece of music or whatever






