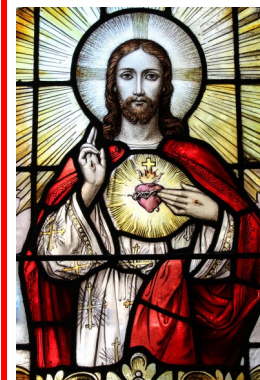


Grandparents' Group

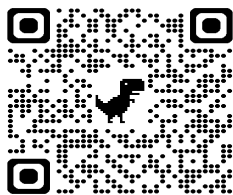

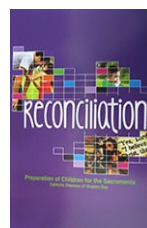

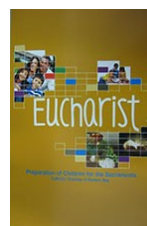

Bookclub

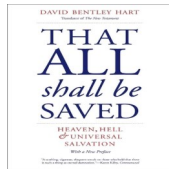
Next Friday our bookclub club will be discussing David Bentley Hart's book "That All Shall be Saved". Hart came to prominence some years ago with a provocative book- Atheist Delusions-that took aim at "atheism that consists entirely in vacuous arguments afloat on oceans of historical ignorance". That book also critiqued what is often called "the Enlightenment project".

With his book That All Shall be Saved, he argues that the idea of an eternal hell is incoherent with a merciful God. He claims theologically that God intends that all will eventually be saved and that this view was prominent among some of the early church fathers. There are many who are sympathetic to this idea so the discussion should be intoxicating. Join us if this might interest you.

In July we will be reading Brant Pitre's book "Jesus and the Jewish Roots of the Eucharist".

In August we will read Shusaku Endo's 1993 novel Deep River about four Japanese tourists on a pilgrimage to the Ganges in India in search of spiritual discoveries. Many may be more familiar with his book "Silence" which has been made into a film by Martin Scorsese.

Our book club meets on the last Friday of every month in the parish offices at 1600.
