New Sunday Morning Mass Times

Since 2022 the PPC has been discussing a proposal to decrease the number of Sunday morning Masses from three to two.

Permission has been given to make the change; the Parish has been consulted and most agree with the new times of **7.30am and 9.30am**; and this proposal has been sent to the Bishop for his approval.

When we have this, we will set a date for the changeover; the new times will be well advertised in the parish before any change happens; and a review will be conducted six months after the change.

Through the Desert God Leads us to Freedom

is a simple Lenten resource prepared by Fr Kenneth Hagen based on Pope Francis' Message for Lent 2024. It is just one page, with one question for your reflection each week of Lent. *Copies are available at the door of the church.*

In his message the Pope invites all Christians to reflect on ways by which we can leave the "desert" of the present time and discover the "freedom" which God offers his people.

Question Two: What ideas and opinions which I have limit me in serving others?



Preparing for Easter

The 40 days of Lent are our time of reflection and penance. They prepare us for the greatest event in human history – the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead. This is the foundation of our faith. As St Paul put it, "if Christ be not risen then we witness in vain." (1 Corinthians 15:14).

But what is the resurrection? What is the story behind it?

How do all the Gospel accounts form a complete picture?

And why are the accounts so brief about the 40 days between the resurrection and the ascension?

What is the role of women in the resurrection?

Why is it so significant?

As part of our Lenten preparation, we will be exploring these questions on **Thursday 29th February at 7pm in the Parish Office.**

In a second session, later in Lent we will explore other themes relating to Easter:

The last judgement. What will happen? What do we know about it?

Why do the Jehovah Witnesses say only 144,000 people can go to heaven?

Why do so many Christian denominations believe there will be a 1,000-year reign of Christ on earth?

Explore our faith. Understand the message of Christ. **Come along.** No need to register. Christ himself said: "you shall learn the truth and the truth will make you free." (John 8:31).

We pray for Peace

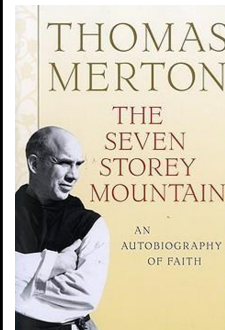
