Easing of COVID Restrictions

During the week we received a letter from the Vicar General informing us that "we are now free to return to the availability of **holy water in fonts** at the entrances to our churches" and added that "we should seek to maintain the fonts in the most hygienic way possible".

The VG also stated that "for the time being the Eucharist must only be distributed to the Faithful through the Body of Christ. The **sharing of the Chalice** amongst the people is not yet to be reintroduced".

From the PPC: Catholic schools

Our parish is blessed to have an excellent Catholic school adjacent to our church. Catholic education in Australia has been an outstanding success in maintaining the faith. Ten new catholic schools were opened last year across Australia and the census data show 793,000 students were enrolled in Catholic schools in 2022. This means that close to 21 % of all children in Australia are now educated in Catholic schools. This is higher than the census figures for people who acknowledge themselves to be Catholic, which in 2021 was 20% of the population.

Like the church itself Catholic schools are different in the 21st century to what many in the parish would remember from their own schooling days. Most noticeable of course is that they are now totally lay run; another significant difference is the number of non-Catholics now attending Catholics schools. Both of these factors impact on the presentation of the mission of Catholic education.

In our own parish we appreciate the continued involvement of John Barton, the Principal of OLSS school, in the Parish Pastoral Council. The PPC looks forward to working with the school in 2023 in the development of a junior choir for Saturday night Masses and the training of junior servers to serve at Sunday Masses. In addition, Fr Vince works with the school for grade Masses and in the sacramental programs for Confirmation, Reconciliation and Holy Communion.

School enrolment has held steady with around 560 students commencing this year. This is an acknowledgement of the good standing with which the school is held in our community. A decision to send a child to a Catholic school involves for many parents a considerable financial commitment. The foundation of the Catholic Faith continues to be in the home but the school plays a vital role in nourishing and developing it.

Book Club

On Friday the book club discussed Elizabeth Lev's book *How Catholic Art Saved the Faith-The Triumph of Beauty and Truth in Counter-Reformation Art*. Part history, part art appreciation, reading the book is a reminder of a comment made by Pope Benedict XVI to clergy in 2008; 'art and the saints are the greatest apologetic for our faith'. The book covers a period of great turmoil in the church. Art became an effective means of explaining the sacraments to a largely unlettered public, and the church enlisted the skill of some of the greatest artists of the era. 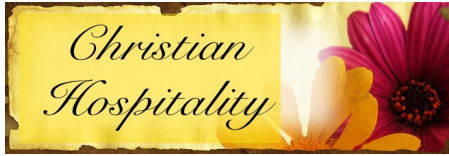
