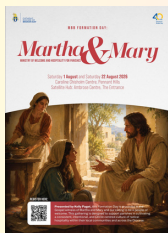

Formation Day: "Martha and Mary: A Ministry of Welcome and Hospitality for Parishes."

1st August and 22nd August

Presented by Kelly Paget, this Formation Day is grounded in the Gospel witness of Martha and Mary and our calling to be a people of welcome. This gathering is designed to support parishes in cultivating a consistent, intentional, and Christ-centred culture of radical hospitality within their local communities and across the Diocese. This is a planned two part-series of Saturdays designed for Clergy, Parish Pastoral Council Members, Parish Ministry leaders and all interested parishioners.

The Memorial of Saints Martha, Mary and Lazarus celebrates three saints who were the embodiment of this theme. In the story of Lazarus, Jesus Christ calls the dead man to new life. He knocks on the door and Lazarus responds. "The account of the resurrection of Lazarus, then, invites us to listen to this profound need [for Christ] and, with the power of the Holy Spirit, to free our hearts from habits, conditioning and ways of thinking which, like boulders, shut us away in the tomb of selfishness, materialism, violence and superficiality," Pope Leo XIV said during his 22nd March 2026 Angelus. Lazarus' sisters, Mary and Martha, also embody this spirit of listening and desire to respond by serving God. "One of the sisters welcomes him by serving him, while the other sits at his feet, listening as a disciple would her teacher," Pope Leo XIV said. "As we know, Jesus responds to the first sister's complaints that she would like some help with the tasks at hand by inviting her to recognise the value of listening. It would be incorrect, however, to see these two attitudes as mutually exclusive, or to compare the merits of the two women. Service and listening are, in fact, twin dimensions of hospitality. "Our relationship with God comes first. Although it is true that we must live out our faith through concrete actions, faithfully carrying out our duties according to our state of life and vocation, it is essential that we do so only after meditating on the Word of God and listening to what the Holy Spirit is saying to our hearts."

Our book club in August will be reading

C S Lewis' "**Surprised by Joy**". It is an account of Lewis' conversion and his encounter with the hidden divine. The title of the book comes from a poem by Wordsworth: Surprised by Joy- Impatient as the Wind / I turned to share the transport-Oh! with whom / But Thee, deep buried in the silent tomb. Like many of his era he was influenced by G K Chesterton. Having read Chesterton's "**The Everlasting Man**" he saw for the first time "the whole Christian outline of history set out in a form that seemed to make sense." His final conversion came in the side-car of his brother's motorcycle while on the way to the zoo. "When we set out, I did not believe that Jesus Christ is the son of God, and when we reached the zoo I did. This book is one of the great conversion stories.

In September our group will be focussing on Pope Leo's encyclical **Magnifica Humanitas** - a reflection on the role of AI in our lives. Join us if you can.

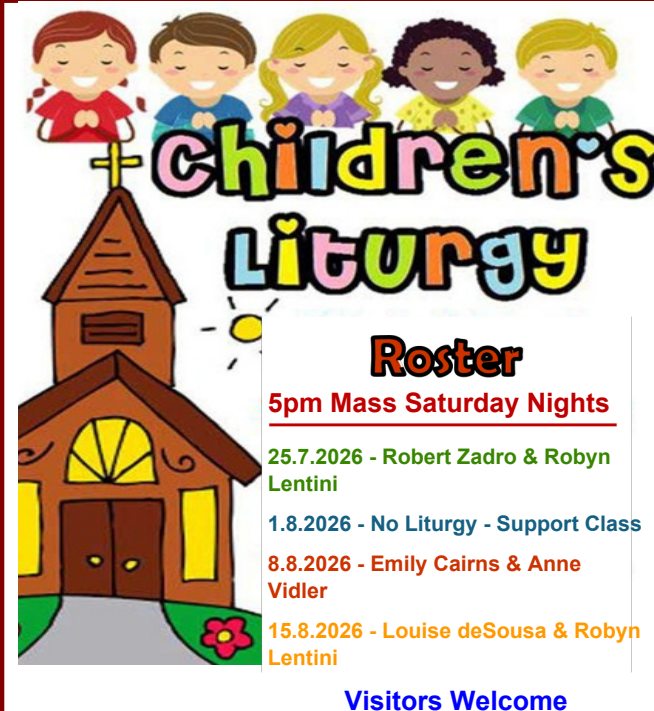
What is spiritual direction?

In spiritual direction you reflect deeply on the experiences of your daily life, your loves, hurts, dreams, joys and fears.

Gradually, as you contemplate, you may begin to discover how God's spirit is moving in your life and that God has been waiting for you to see this closer relationship.

Spiritual direction is really not about being directed, nor is it therapy, or counselling. Rather, it is very much about being encouraged to draw closer to God whether that be in your prayer life, relationships, in nature, or in the events of your life. The privilege and responsibility of a spiritual director is to journey with you, in one-on-one conversations, as you deepen your relationship with God. What is shared is held in confidence. A meeting time is agreed upon, usually once a month, for an hour.
