The Coming of Christ

Commencing Thursday 30th November at 7pm.

Have you ever wondered why Mary travelled 90 miles from Nazareth to Bethlehem riding on a donkey when she was 8 months pregnant as only Joseph was required to register according to the Roman Emperor's decree?

Have you wondered why we celebrate Christmas on 25th December – in the Orthodox churches it is on 7th January?

MEN'S BUSHWALKING GROUP



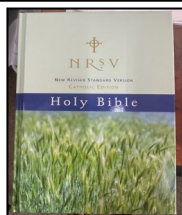

Christmas Appeal



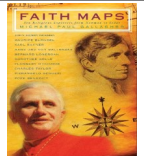
Next weekend the St Vincent de Paul Society

a place where time itself seems suspended. A novel
based on the life of Archbishop Jean Baptiste Lamy.

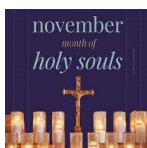

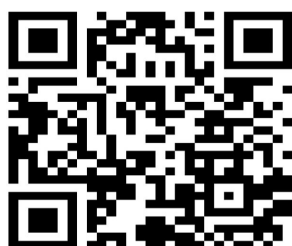

What is spiritual direction?



In spiritual direction you reflect deeply on the experiences of your daily life, your loves, hurts, dreams, joys and fears.

Gradually, as you contemplate, you may begin to discover how God's spirit is moving in your life and that God has been waiting for you to see this closer relationship.

Spiritual direction is really not about being directed, nor is it therapy, or counselling. Rather, it is very much about being encouraged to draw closer to God whether that be in your prayer life, relationships, in nature, or in the events of your life. The privilege and responsibility of a spiritual director is to journey with you, in one-on-one conversations, as you deepen your relationship with God. What is shared is held in confidence.

A meeting time is agreed upon, usually once a month, for an hour.
