Lent

This Wednesday (2 March) is Ash Wednesday when ashes are distributed to mark the beginning of Lent.

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fast and abstinence. All those between the age of 18 and 60 are required to fast. This may vary for different people, but a guide is to have one ordinary meal and two small meals and no snacks. Everyone above the age of 14 is required to abstain from eating meat on these days.

Every Friday of the year (including those of Lent) are days of penance when we are required to do one act of prayer, self-denial or helping others.

We are all also required to receive Holy Communion at least once between Ash Wednesday and Trinity Sunday (12 June) and to confess our grave sins at least once a year.

The Bishop's letter explaining more about Lent and these requirements was attached to the electronic version of the parish bulletin, some copies are at the door of the church, and it is on the notice board near the Parish Offices.


The Legion is celebrating its 100 years this year and a Centenary Statue of Our Lady will be visiting our Parish from 8 March to 15 March. More details next week.






