NOVEMBER THE MONTH OF THE HOLY SOULS - Please find the November Mass envelopes in the pews and at the back of the church. We believe that those Holy Souls for whom we pray will continue to pray for us after they have been released from Purgatory. If we live Christian lives, we too will likely find ourselves in Purgatory someday, and our acts of charity toward the Holy Souls there now will ensure that they remember us before the throne of God when we are most in need of prayers. It’s a comforting thought, and one that should encourage us, especially in this month of November, to offer our prayers for the Holy Souls. The Church offers [a special plenary indulgence](#), applicable only to the souls in [Purgatory](#), on [All Souls Day](#). To be able to gain an indulgence, the faithful must be in the state of grace receiving the **sacrament of confession**, either eight days before or after, receive **Holy Communion** on that day, and recite **prayers for the intentions of the Holy Father** (one Our Father, one Hail Mary is the minimum, but any other additional prayers may be added). We can also obtain an indulgence by visiting the Cemetery between 1st and the 8th November and reciting prayers.
