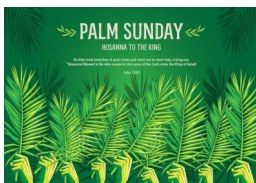

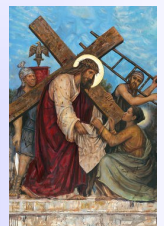

The Season of Lent

is a time of preparation for the celebration of Easter.

Walking in the Wilderness is the Lenten Program from Broken Bay which focuses on the Sunday Readings and is designed to be used both individually or within a group setting.

On Good Friday **abstinence from meat** is to be observed by those who have completed their fourteenth year of age. Those who are aged between 18 and 60 are also required to **fast** on these days. To "fast" means eating two small meals and one normal meal, and nothing else during the day.



On all other **Fridays in Lent** the law of the common practice of penance is fulfilled by an act of prayer, self-denial or helping others. Between Ash Wednesday and Trinity Sunday (at the end of Easter) all the faithful are obliged to receive **Holy Communion** and to **confess** any grave sins.

Project Compassion boxes and envelopes are available at the back of the church.

Bible Study and Discussion

We begin our study of The Gospel of St Luke

We begin "The Letter to The Romans".

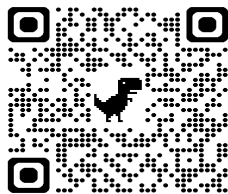

Congratulations to our Bishop

Pope Leo has appointed Bishop Anthony Randazzo as Prefect of the Dicastery for Legislative Texts, with the personal title of Archbishop. The Archbishop will move to the Vatican in three months. "I am profoundly grateful to Pope Leo for the confidence and trust he has placed in me," Archbishop Randazzo, 59 and a canon law graduate of the Pontifical Gregorian University, said. The Dicastery for Legislative Texts serves the Pope in promoting and safeguarding the proper understanding, interpretation, and application of canon law across the universal Church. As Prefect, Archbishop Randazzo will oversee the Dicastery's work in formulating authentic interpretations of universal Church law, offering authoritative clarifications on juridical questions, and assisting in the development and refinement of canonical legislation. He will also guide collaboration with other dicasteries, episcopal conferences, and canonists worldwide to ensure coherence and integrity in the Church's legal framework. "During my time as Bishop of the Diocese of Broken Bay the clergy and faithful have been a true joy in my episcopal ministry. I remain forever grateful to God, who entrusted me with the care of His flock."

Spiritual direction is really not about being directed, nor is it therapy, or counselling. Rather, it is very much about being encouraged to draw closer to God whether that be in your prayer life, relationships, in nature, or in the events of your life. The privilege and responsibility of a spiritual director is to journey with you, in one-on-one conversations, as you deepen your relationship with God. What is shared is held in confidence.

A meeting time is agreed upon, usually once a month, for an hour.

Bookclub

Our book club in April will be reading C S Lewis' book **Mere Christianity**. Based on a series of lectures that Lewis gave at the invitation of the BBC, only months after the London blitz. These lectures were eventually collected and published as a book, which became immensely popular as an introduction to Christian faith. A contemporary of Tolkien, Dorothy Sayers, Evelyn Waugh and G K Chesterton his books, particularly the Narnia series, have been read by millions. They give expression to this 'Christ haunted world' and remind us of what is truly important.

In May we will read Bishop Robert Barron's little book on **Saint Thomas Aquinas**. Published by Word on Fire, Aquinas is, along with St Augustine, one of the most prominent theologians in the catholic faith. Theology is not an academic exercise but a matter of spiritual life or death, and so Bishop Barron reminds us that at the core of Aquinas' writing is a deep love of the Lord. 
