Giving in the Parish

We have **two regular collections** in the parish each weekend.

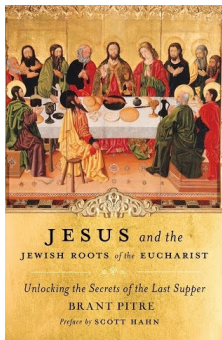
The First Collection goes to a common fund (Pastoral Revenue) across all diocesan parishes and is used to support the Bishop and all the priests (active and retired) in the Diocese. Donations for Baptisms, Weddings, Funerals and Easter and Christmas offerings go to the Pastoral Revenue.

The Second Collection goes to our Church Account and stays in the parish and is used to meet all our expenses. Rents, planned giving, regular direct debits and other donations (unless explicitly directed elsewhere) go to the Church Account. Funds from the account built, and is now used to maintain the church, hall, offices, presbytery and grounds. It pays for all our running costs including insurance, employment and office, church and pastoral expenses. Donations through *Tap 'n' Go* in the church and *Donate Now* on our website go to the Church Account.

All other **special collections** go to the charity or activity advertised when we have the appeal.

What is spiritual direction?

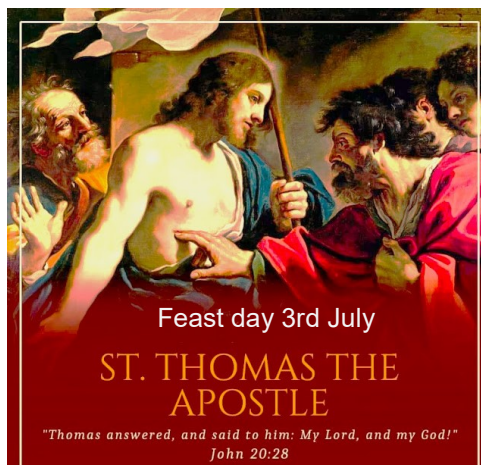
In spiritual direction you reflect deeply on the experiences of your daily life, your loves, hurts, dreams, joys and fears.

Gradually, as you contemplate, you may begin to discover how God's spirit is moving in your life and that God has been waiting for you to see this closer relationship.

Spiritual direction is really not about being directed, nor is it therapy, or counselling. Rather, it is very much about being encouraged to draw closer to God whether that be in your prayer life, relationships, in nature, or in the events of your life. The privilege and responsibility of a spiritual director is to journey with you, in one-on-one conversations, as you deepen your relationship with God. What is shared is held in confidence.

A meeting time is agreed upon, usually once a month, for an hour.

Saints Peter and Paul

On Sunday, the Church celebrates the Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul, the two foundational pillars of the Church.

In the past few Sundays, the Church's liturgical celebrations have been centred on the founding of the Church.

On the Solemnity of Pentecost, we celebrated the foundation of the Church, when the Holy Spirit descended on the Apostles and they began their ministry.

On the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity, we celebrated God, the centre of the Church's life and existence.

On the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi) the Church celebrates the source and summit of the Christian life.

Now, this Sunday, 29 June, the Church venerates the martyrdom of Saints Peter and Paul, who died in Rome. The two are the patron saints of Rome, the preeminent Church.

Saints Peter and Paul are considered the foundational pillars of the Church.

Peter represents the unity and stability of the Church as the Vicar of Christ and Bishop of Rome. Paul represents the Church's mission of evangelisation and conversion.

Both men were called by Christ to a new life in Him, and to help found His Church. They were steadfast and faithful in this mission, travelling to the heart of the Roman Empire to preach the Good News and to found the Church.
