

Shrine to St John Paull
And
Installation of Relics

The Diocese of Broken Bay now has Australia's first national Shrine to St John Paul II – but it is a Shrine for all of Australia. More than a thousand people gathered at St Patrick's Church, East Gosford last Saturday to celebrate the inauguration of the Shrine to St John Paul II and the installation of two first-class relics.

Relics of saints are not worshipped but venerated as a means of asking for the intercession of that saint. They direct us towards the life and faith of the saint, which directs us towards God. Bishop Randazzo also officially opened and blessed the adjacent Pastoral Centre, which will form part of the pilgrimage site. It will include a display dedicated to St John Paul II, and facilities for speakers and conferences.

"I encourage people throughout the Diocese, and indeed right around the country, to visit the Shrine. Make this Shrine, this sanctuary of love, a place to intercede through St John Paul II for vocations, to the married life, to the consecrated life, to the single life and to the ordained priestly and deaconal life. This will become a great powerhouse to continue the wonderful work that is already happening in this Diocese and in the Church right across Australia.

"I hope and pray that our prayers will radiate from this sanctuary, from this Shrine, for the good of our Church and for the good of the world in which we live."

The Shrine will be open daily, and the relics will be permanently housed in the reliquary, allowing people to come and pray before them throughout the year.
