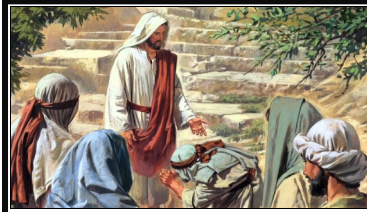

Plenary Council. October 2020.

Preparation for the Plenary Council is now at stage II, namely the discernment. Those especially interested can obtain further information on the Broken Bay diocese web-site at evangelisation@bbcatholic.org.au

Six themes, set out below, have been identified as the themes for the Plenary Council.

This is a once in a lifetime opportunity for all Catholics to have a say in the future of their Church. The Church founded by our Divine Saviour. (Matthew 16.18-19)

From the point of view of our parish we are asked to arrange groups of interested parishioners to discernment sessions. These sessions will involve scripture readings appropriate to the theme, a report on the theme and discussion. The diocese has requested the discernment session start with the parish pastoral council. At its meeting last Tuesday the parish pastoral council endorsed the program for further parish involvement. We need to see this as the first step in a very long road towards greater involvement of the laity at both parish and diocesan level. In addition an invitation will be extended to all parish units such as the St Vincent DePaul Society, Catholic Women's League, Social Justice Group and other parish groupings to be separately briefed and where possible separately involved.

The 6 themes are:

**Missionary and Evangelising
Inclusive, Participatory and Synodal
Prayerful and Eucharistic
Humble Healing and Merciful
Joyful Hope Filled and Servant Community
Open to Conversion, Renewal and Reform.**

The pastoral council also agreed to seek the co operation, through the school, of the school community, both teachers and parents.


The sessions will be chaired by the pastoral council or their appointees.

All are asked to prayerfully examine the themes and consider their own views on them.
