### WHY DO WE DO THAT? Catholic Life Explained

#### **Question:**

When Jesus says, "You cannot serve both God and mammon," what does he mean? What is mammon?

#### Answer:

When you hear Scripture proclaimed each Sunday, remember it wasn't originally written in English. Hebrew, Aramaic, Greek — these ancient tongues were the original language of our Old and New Testaments. Most of the time, all of the words are translated into our native language. Sometimes, a word or two is left in the original language. Such is the case in this Scripture passage.

Mammon is an ancient Aramaic word referring to money, wealth, or profit. Earthly wealth isn't bad in itself, nor does it automatically exclude us from being a disciple of Jesus. But what dominates our life? To serve money — that is, to seek accumulation of wealth for its own sake and to structure our lives around it — is morally problematic. What good is our wealth if it isn't at the service of others? What good is our wealth if its pursuit leads us to selfishness, obsession, greed, envy, and comparison? There are many things that can be opposed to our service of God — power, prestige, popularity. Ultimately, something in our lives will be our master. But there is only one God worth serving. **©LPi**

### **BRINGING HOME THE GOSPEL**

Jesus answers his own question very clearly in this parable: Even the person you trust least is your neighbour. The Samaritan, despised by the Jews, helps a Jew. He goes out of his way to make sure the injured man is taken care of. The story is a testimony not only to who our neighbour is, but also to what it means to be a neighbour.

The Samaritan doesn't just stop to help the injured man; he carries him on his own animal to an inn where he leaves instructions with the innkeeper to take care of him. He even leaves enough money to pay for the injured man's needs, offering to pay any additional charges on his return.

This story reminds me of the illustration of a young boy carrying a smaller child on his shoulders, the sketch that accompanies the motto for Boys Town: "He ain't heavy; he's my brother." That is the lesson of the parable with the underlying awareness that we are all brothers and sisters.

When we see or even hear about someone in need, we are asked to put our own misgivings and prejudices aside and lift them up, just as the Samaritan did, just as the youngster commemorated in the illustration did, just as Christ is willing to do for us each time we fail or need to be carried.

#### FAMILY RESPONSE:

Go through a newspaper or a newsmagazine together and find pictures of people from another culture or country. Talk about what the picture tells you about the way they live. Imagine what it would be like to trade places with them.

### PERSONAL RESPONSE:

Prejudice is something that is subtly passed from generation to generation. What prejudices did the family you grew up in have? Do you hold the same prejudices? How do you handle prejudice?

whether our environmental behaviour is consistent with our faith, we need to ask ourselves, "What would Jesus do?" Or better yet, "What does Jesus want to do through us?"
