WDP's motto is "Informed prayer leads to prayerful action.

Coordinated services of Christian worship and prayer are held across the world in over 170 countries, directed by the

international body – the World Day of Prayer International. The program for the service is prepared well in advance by women from one focus country of theworld. Each service has an advertised theme and involves Bible readings, prayers and songs and a reflection and is attended by women and men.
