## WHY DO WE DO THAT?

### Catholic Life Explained

#### Question:

What does it mean to discern a vocation?

#### Answer:

The word vocation comes from the Latin word *vocare*, meaning "to call." A vocation is a calling or invitation from God to serve in a particular way. For Catholics, that calling might be as a priest, sister, or married person. Vocation is the way we respond to the invitation to share in God's grace and witness to God's love in the world.

Discerning a vocation is the process in which we pray for God's guidance. We listen for God's message that is often quiet and unassuming in a world filled with noise and distractions. We look at our gifts and talents, seek the advice of others, examine our motives, and listen to see what God is asking of us. The goal of discernment is to follow what the Lord wills, not what we think is the best idea. Many men enter a seminary to discern if that is their vocation, only to discover that their calling is to marriage. Others have resisted the idea for long periods of time, until finally they could resist no more. Some great saints have described that dilemma. Vocation is a human process of divine origin, and each of us must strive constantly to hear the call of God in our lives.

## ANZAC DAY: Remembering, Honouring, Praying for Peace

On this ANZAC Day we pause as a nation to remember the courage, sacrifice, and service of those who have given so much in times of war and conflict. For many in our parish, this day carries a deeply personal meaning - a parent, grandparent, sibling, or friend who served; stories passed down, and memories held close.

Within our own parish family, we are blessed to have among us Fr Abel, who served as a chaplain in the Royal Australian Air Force from 1975 to 1982. Four years' service at Forest Hill Air Force Base near Wagga Wagga providing Character Guidance courses to apprentices and meeting the Welfare needs of other serving personnel. He was then sent overseas to serve at Butterworth Air Base in Malaysia where he looked after a Parish-like community of families scattered over both Butterworth and Penang Island, with two chapels, providing 2 masses each week at each. His ministry to those serving far from home, offering spiritual care and presence in times of uncertainty, reminds us that service takes many forms. He finished his final fourteen months of military service at Richmond Air Base outside Sydney, doing mainly religious duties and welfare work. Fr Abel's recognition with The Australian Service Medal (with clasp for overseas service) and the Australian Defence Medal speaks not only of duty, but of faithful accompaniment.

ANZAC Day invites us not only to remember the past, but to reflect on the future we are called to build. In the words of Pope Leo XIV, we are reminded that true peace is not simply the absence of conflict, but the presence of justice, compassion, and a commitment to one another. Peace begins in the human heart and grows through acts of understanding, mercy, and reconciliation.

Today we honour those who served. We give thanks for their sacrifice. And we pray for a world where such sacrifice is no longer required.

**Lest we forget.**

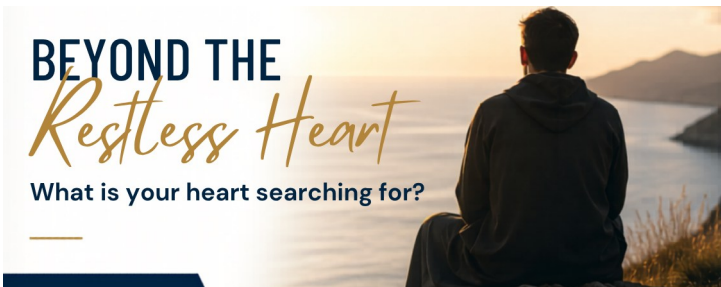

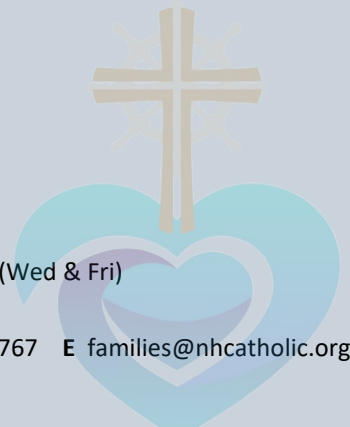

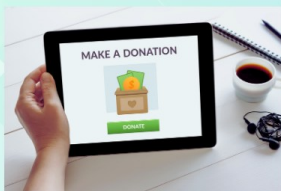
