#### **IMPORTANT ANNOUNCEMENT for COMMUNION**

With the extensive media coverage regarding the outbreak of novel coronavirus. Although NSW Health has deemed the risk of the virus to the general public as low, a number of precautionary recommendations have been issued in order to limit its spread.

In light of these guidelines, Bishop Anthony has asked to convey the following instructions that are pertinent to any such situations of general community health concern:

- 1. As from 2 February, the chalice is not to be shared at any Masses but is to be reserved to the Celebrant(s) only.
- 2. All Ministers of Communion (Ordinary and Extraordinary) are to be diligent in the use of hand sanitiser prior to the distribution of Communion.
- 3.Such precautions remain in force until the end of February, upon which time Bishop Anthony will review the situation in light of any further developments.

#### **Automated Electrical Defibrillators (AED)**



To ensure the safety and wellbeing of our parishioners, an Automated Electrical Defibrillator (AED) has been purchased and installed in both of our Churches.

Cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) and defibrillation via an Automated Electrical

Defibrillator (AED) are proven interventions that can effectively treat cardiac arrest. The use of an AED can improve the chances of a person's survival dramatically.

Anyone can use an AED on someone who is suspected of being in cardiac arrest. You do not need specialised AED training to use an AED. Call triple (000) to seek emergency assistance. The operator will direct the caller how to use an AED if it is available.

#### **Second Reading** 1 Cor 3:16-23 A reading from the first letter of St Paul to the Corinthians

All things are yours, but you belong to Christ and Christ belongs to God.

Didn't you realise that you were God's temple and that the Spirit of God was living among you? If anybody should destroy the temple of God, God will destroy him, because the temple of God is sacred; and you are that temple.

Make no mistake about it: if any one of you thinks of himself as wise, in the ordinary sense of the word, then he must learn to be a fool before he really can be wise. Why? Because the wisdom of this world is foolishness to God. As scripture says: The Lord knows wise men's thoughts: he knows how useless they are, or again: God is not convinced by the arguments of the wise. So there is nothing to boast about in anything human: Paul, Apollos, Cephas, the world, life and death, the present and the future, are all your servants; but you belong to Christ and Christ belongs to God.

#### The word of the Lord

#### **Gospel Acclamation**

Alleluia, alleluia! Whoever keeps the word of Christ, grows perfect in the love of God. Alleluia!

Gospel Mt 5:38-48 A reading from the holy Gospel according to Matthew

1 Jn 2:5

Love your enemies.

Jesus said to his disciples: 'You have learnt how it was said: Eye for eye and tooth for tooth. But I say this to you: offer the wicked man no resistance. On the contrary, if anyone hits you on the right cheek, offer him the other as well; if a man takes you to law and would have your tunic, let him have your cloak as well. And if anyone orders you to go one mile, go two miles with him. Give to anyone who asks, and if anyone wants to borrow, do not turn away.

'You have learnt how it was said: You must love your neighbour and hate your enemy. But I say this to you: love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you; in this way you will be sons of your Father in heaven, for he causes his sun to rise on bad men as well as good, and his rain to fall on honest and dishonest men alike. For if you love those who love you, what right have you to claim any credit? Even the tax collectors do as much, do they not? And if you save your greetings for your brothers, are you doing anything exceptional? Even the pagans do as much, do they not? You must therefore be perfect just as your heavenly Father is perfect.

#### The Gospel of the Lord

#### Reflection

At times it seems we have rewritten the 'Golden Rule' to say: Do unto others before they can do unto you! In saying this we are not encouraging each other to do good, but to be defensive. Jesus tells us to go the extra mile, turn the other cheek, outdo ourselves in generosity and rise above the fray. He is not suggesting that we allow ourselves to be abused, but that we not perpetuate the antagonism out of which the mistreatment arose. He is not advocating passivity, but he is saying that we should not retaliate. Jesus is describing what we today would call active non-resistance, the attitude taught by Gandhi and Martin Luther King.

We are familiar with the answer to the question: Who is my neighbour? We usually interpret it to mean those we do not particularly like. It is important to love them, to be kind to them, to help them when they are in need. But these are not the people whom Jesus is talking about in today's reading. He tells us that the neighbours whom we are to love are those people who do not like us. We are to love those who deliberately exclude us from their social circles, who talk about us behind our backs. We are to love those who make us feel that we are not

good enough for them, those who resent us for our accomplishments. We are to love those who exploit us or do us harm. This is indeed a radical teaching.

It is therefore fitting to have several penitential celebrations during Lent, so that all the faithful may have an opportunity to be reconciled with God and their neighbour and so be able to celebrate the paschal mystery in the Easter Triduum with renewed hearts. RP 13 The Sacrament of Penance is better celebrated before rather than during the Easter Triduum.

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fast and abstinence.

The law of fasting binds those who have completed their eighteenth year, until the beginning of their sixtieth year; the law of abstinence binds those who have completed their fourteenth year (CCL 97, 1251-52).


