Unit Focus:

In Class:

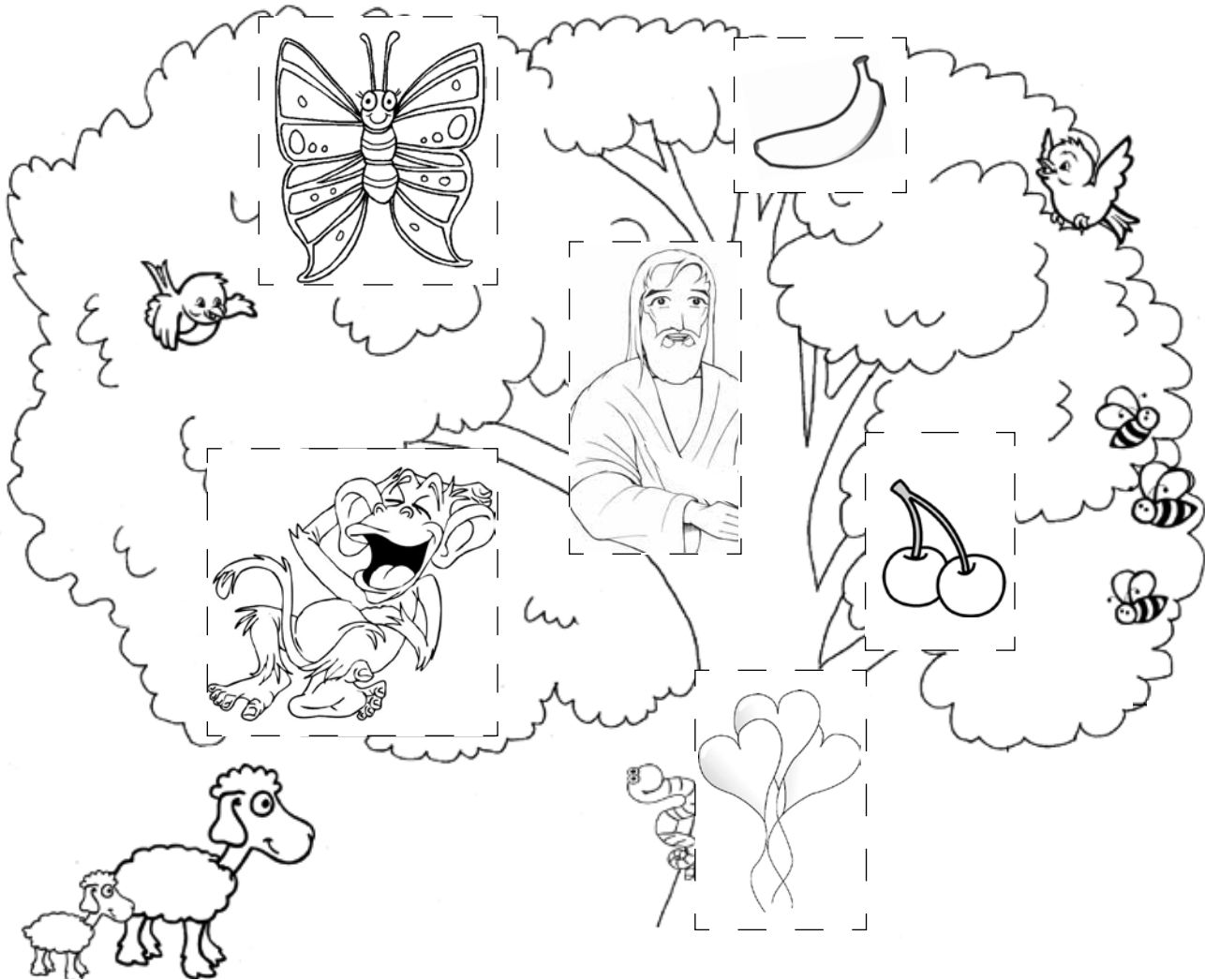
Students explore the story of Jesus and Zacchaeus (Luke 19:1-10). In their books they help Jesus find Zack in the maze and illustrate the story.
