

Easter: Jesus is with Us

Unit Focus:

Students study post-Resurrection stories and their significance for the Church today and are given opportunities to further develop skills and strategies to engage in meaningful prayer with God. The emphasis in this unit is on the students' ability to recognise and encounter the Risen Christ in their own lives.

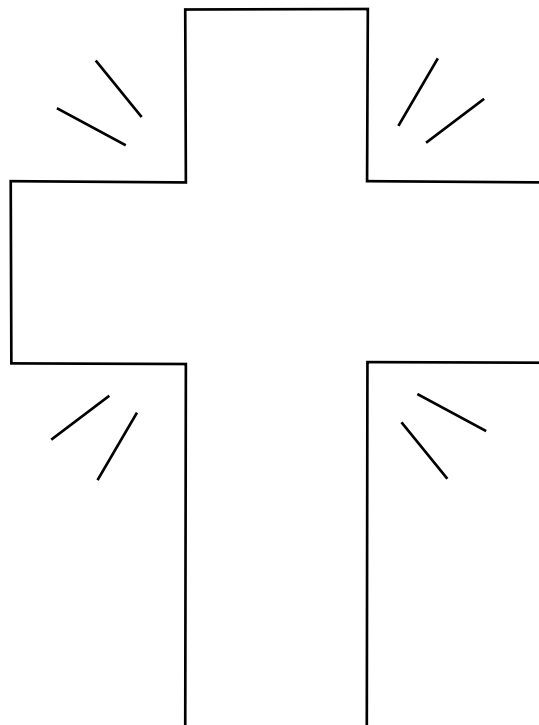
Students are challenged to:

- Recognise the implications of Jesus' words and actions.
- Show reverence and appreciation towards the Bible.

In Class:

Students identify kind words and mean words and explore how when we are kind we are being like Jesus. ('Prayer is a way Jesus is present in us'.)

The class prays together to be kind and be more like Jesus. They then complete the activity joining the letters of the alphabet to form a heart.

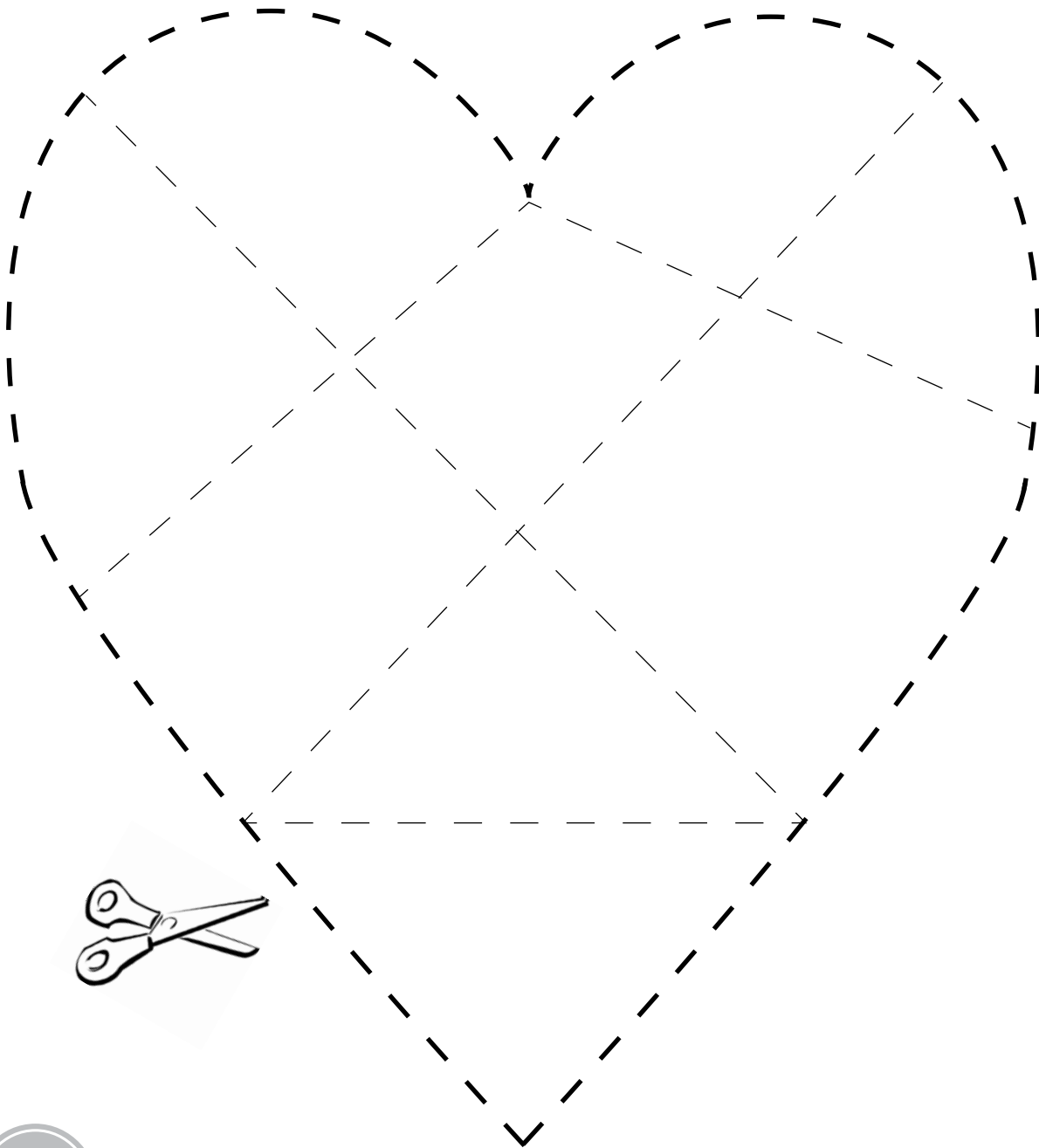


Jesus is Present with Us

Aim: Recognise Jesus' presence in our words and actions.

Heart Puzzle

Ask your family to write kind words to describe you in the shapes with a texta. Then, colour in the whole heart shape and glue it on cardboard. Cut out the different shapes to make a heart puzzle. Mix it up and then put it back together.



OR:

Stick a copy of a photo of yourself on the heart shape or draw a picture.
