Loving like Jesus



Unit Focus:

Students relate their experience of the loving actions of family and others to the example of Jesus through a study of 'Jesus and the Blind Beggar' (Lk 18:35-43). Students learn how Christians can love God through their relationships with others and are encouraged to identify how they can participate in the mission of Jesus through loving God and other people.

Students are challenged to:

- Recognise the implications of Jesus' words and actions.
- Reach out to others in love as Jesus did.

In Class:

Begin with prayer, inviting the Holy Spirit to come into the hearts and minds of everyone to remind us God would like us to be more like Jesus.

Students look at pictures of the marginalised on the sacred space and explore what would Jesus do if he was with these people now? What can we do when we met people who need help?
