In Class:

Waiting in Hope

Aim: Realise we are part of a people who waited for the birth of Jesus.

l. Pupple We prepare by turning away from anything that will keep us from Jesus.

3. Pink We become joyful because the time for Jesus to come is very near.

We **wait in Joyful hope** for the **coming of Jesus** at Christmas. We prepare by lighting a new candle each week for four weeks and saying a prayer together.
