Unit Focus:

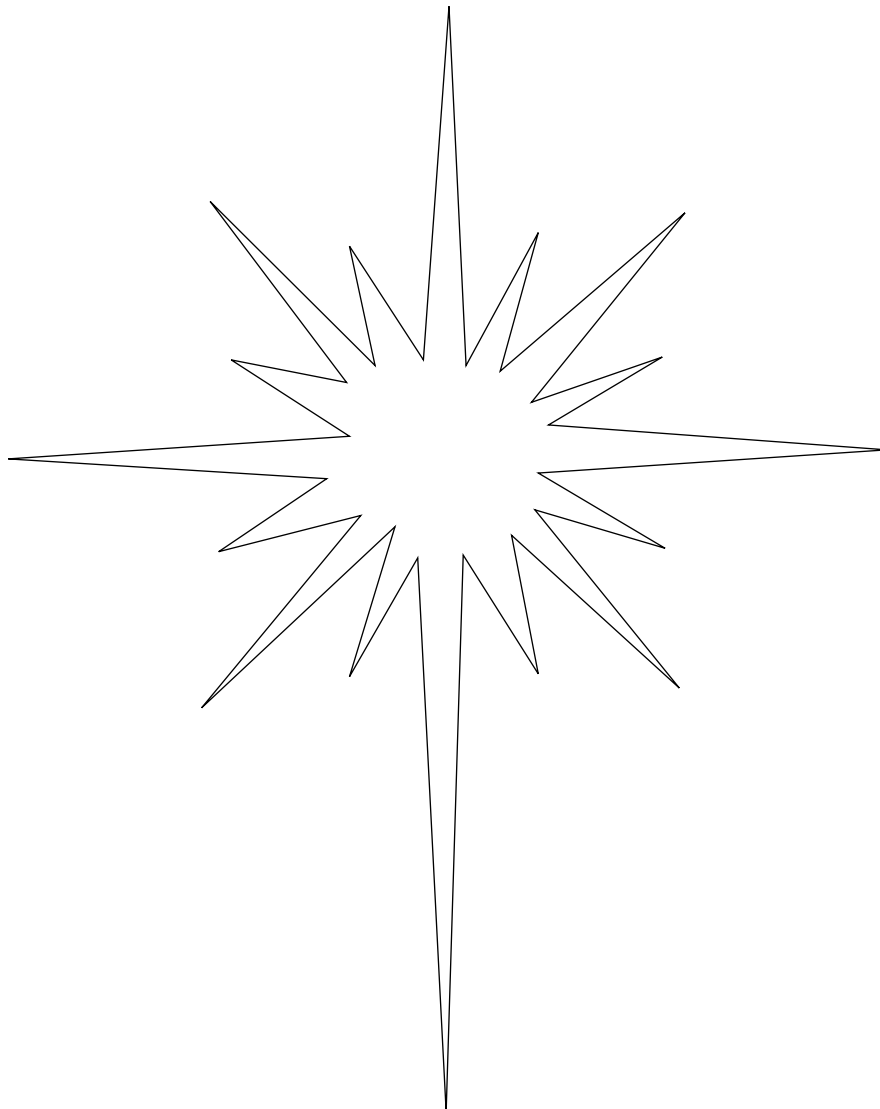
Students relate experiences of celebrating Christmas to biblical accounts of how Mary and Joseph, the shepherds and wise men responded to the birth of Jesus. They participate in activities which reinforce the true meaning of Christmas as a time of happiness when we celebrate the birth of Jesus and receive and spread God's love, peace and joy.

Students are challenged to:

- Participate in school and parish worship.
- Recognise God's presence in the world.

In Class:

Students explore the Nativity story through actions. Various students take part (three wise men, three shepherds, Angel, Mary with baby Jesus doll, Joseph).
