Easter: Together



Unit Focus:

Students examine the events of the first Easter Sunday and key symbols and rituals used by the Catholic community to celebrate Jesus risen. They participate in a variety of Easter prayers and become more familiar with the symbols associated with the Easter Season.

Students are challenged to:

- Recognise the implications of Jesus' words and actions.
- Show reverence and appreciation towards the Bible.

In Class:

Students have explored how the Paschal Candle is used as a symbol to remind us that Jesus is alive. They then explore the symbols (the cross, A-alpha and Z-omega) and have the to opportunity to illustrate their own candle using these symbols.








Easter Candle
