Communal Rosary

All:

In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

Leader:

Come, O Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of your faithful, and enkindle in them the fire of your love.

Send forth your Spirit, O Lord, and they shall be created.

All:

And you shall renew the face of the earth.

Leader:

Let us pray.

All:

God our Father, pour out the gifts of your Holy Spirit on the world. You sent the Spirit on your Church to begin the teaching of the gospel: now let the Spirit continue to work in the world through the hearts of all who believe. Through Christ our Lord. Amen.

Leader:

You, O Lord, will open my lips.

All:

And my tongue shall announce your praise.

Leader:

Incline unto my aid, O God.

All:

O Lord, make haste to help me.

Leader:

Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit.

All:

As it was in the beginning, is now, and ever shall be, world without end. Amen.

Then follow the five decades of the Rosary with each decade consisting of one Our Father and ten Hail Mary's said aloud while meditating on the particular Mystery.

Leader:

Our Father, who art in heaven, hallowed be Your name; Your kingdom come; Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven.

All:

Give us this day our daily bread; and forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us, and lead us not into temptation; but deliver us from evil. Amen.

Leader:

Hail Mary, full of grace, the Lord is with you; blessed are you among women, and blessed is the fruit of your womb, Jesus.

All:

Holy Mary, Mother of God, pray for us sinners, now and at the hour of our death. Amen.

After each decade:

All: (Fatima Prayer)
