



Background

Joseph House (**House**) is a young men's house of discernment located at 190 High Street, Willoughby, NSW in the Parish of Lower North Shore. The House is an initiative of Bishop Anthony Randazzo in the Diocese of Broken Bay (**Diocese**), governed by the Joseph House Council, and led by Evangelisation Broken Bay. Up to six young men will be accepted as residents of the House, subject to a successful application process.

How to apply to become a resident at the House

Men over the age of 18 years can apply to reside at the House for a period of up to 12-18 months. Together with other residents and the House Manager, it will be a time to contemplate, pray and actively discern their vocation.

The application process is as follows:

- Complete this Application Form and send to <u>josephhouse@bbcatholic.org.au</u>;
- if selected, participate in an interview with the Director of Vocations and Joseph House Council Member/s;
- if successful, sign a Resident's Agreement; and
- provide a Working With Children Check number and National Police History Check report;
- undertake a compulsory Safeguarding induction seminar;
- receive a welcome pack and move into Joseph House.

Selection Criteria

Successful applicants will be chosen based on a demonstrated openness to discerning a vocational call; an aptitude for study, work, and prayer; a willingness to engage in the faith community; and a level of maturity conducive to living in community.

Decisions

All applications will be considered seriously by the Joseph House Council with consultation with the Diocese. It is important to note that spaces at the House are limited and it is at the sole discretion of the Joseph House Council and the Diocese to determine who will be accepted as residents of Joseph House. Successful applicants must agree to comply with rules associated with residency of the house and will sign an agreement before taking up residency. The decision of the Joseph House Council and the Diocese in relation to applications is final.
