





- 72% agree that people of all ages are encouraged to get involved at this local church




## **Church Attendance and Background**



















## How People Relate to Each Other



#### Involvement in groups

- **33%** of people participate in wider community groups
- 8% are very actively involved in online groups (e.g. social media, community groups)



- 82% talk about matters of faith with other members of their household (9% live alone)

- 12% are part of evangelistic activities





## Vision, Innovation & Leadership Culture



### Leadership culture

- **74%** agree that this parish has good and clear systems for how it operates
