## Following His Way

Jesus' words here must have shaken his followers out of any complacency they had left. And for us, they can perform the same service. It is all too easy to think that we have been Baptised; we've been raised as Catholics; we go to Mass; we are doing our bit as Christians. But Baptism is not simply a joyful occasion, celebrated on our behalf by our parents and Godparents when we were babies, or the reason for a party if we are Baptised when we are older. It marks the moment when we enter into following Christ – and his Baptism led to the completion of his ministry – to his resurrection, but via the cross. The Christian vocation is one of service and sacrifice, however joyful it is, because of the graces given to us through Baptism and following Jesus' way.

Yet he understands the courage that fulfilling this mission will require, constantly reassuring his disciples not to be afraid, not to let their hearts be troubled. Instead, we need to keep our eyes on Jesus, as the reading from the Hebrews tells us, to not lose sight of him as we keep going on the race we have started: in other words, our own discipleship.

## Youth Pilgrimage in the Year of Hope 2025

Lachlan Smith, one of our Seaside Youth Leaders, set off on a 4 week pilgrimage on 26 July, tracing the footsteps of several saints and preparing to walk through the Holy Doors of St Peter's Basilica. This extraordinary entrance opens only during Jubilee years, which occur every 25 years, and this year marks the Jubilee of Hope.

Upon arriving in Rome, Lachlan coincided his visit with the Jubilee of Youth week. He attended the opening Youth Mass in St Peter's Square. He shared in the powerful experience of walking and sleeping out with over 1 million young pilgrims from around the globe for the closing Mass at Tor Vergata and met up with young pilgrims from Parramatta Diocese. Remarkably, Lachlan had the opportunity to see Pope Leo XIV up close on two separate occasions.

Following his time in Rome, Lachlan travelled to Lourdes, where he took part in the candlelight procession through the Sanctuary grounds, including the Grotto area, recognised as the site where the Virgin Mary appeared to Saint Bernadette Soubirous. He described this experience as one of the highlights of his pilgrimage thus far.

Following Lourdes, Lachlan travelled to Paris, visiting the Basilica of Sainte-Thérèse of Lisieux, a Catholic church and minor basilica dedicated to Saint Thérèse of Lisieux. He embraced the beauty of multiple landmarks, including the restored Notre Dame Cathedral, a symbol of resilience after the fire in April 2019.

His pilgrimage continues as he heads to Poland to follow in the footsteps of Pope John Paul II, visiting significant sites, including Krakow, where many of his relics are found.

Lachlan is scheduled to return to Sydney on 22 August and will return to Rome to attend the canonisation of Carlo Acutis and Pier Giorgio Frassati on 7 September.

We look forward to hearing about Lachlan's experiences upon his return and ask everyone to keep Lachlan and all the youth of the world in their prayers.

## Explanation of the Ambrose Centre Logo

A legend about St Ambrose as an infant recounts that a swarm of bees settled on his face while he lay in his cradle, leaving behind a drop of honey. His father is said to have considered this a sign of his future eloquence and honeyed tongue. Bees and beehives often appear in the saint's symbology and he is the Patron of beekeepers. Hence in this logo the honeycomb is symbolised with the Cross highlighted inside its pattern.
