At Confirmation, the graces received at Baptism are sealed with reception of the seven gifts of the Holy Spirit. The words Jesus shared with his disciples at Pentecost apply to each one of us at Confirmation: "you will receive the power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; you will be my witnesses" (Acts 1:8).

On the Feast of Corpus Christi

The Confirmation sponsor:

Godparents are the ideal sponsor if they are available, but any Catholic, Baptised person who is 16 years or older and has received the Sacraments of Confirmation and Holy Communion may be a sponsor. Only one sponsor is permitted for each child. Parents cannot be their own child's sponsor.

Important Information for Enrolment in the Sacramental Programme

- **Expressions of Interest** should be completed online prior to enrolment sessions. To finalise the enrolment process, parents or guardians are required to attend one of the three scheduled Information & Enrolment sessions. Please note that children do not need to attend these sessions. See QR Code below to access link to 'Expression of Interest' form via our website. (Enrolment forms can be completed at the Enrolment and Information sessions).
- **Enrolment Fee:** There is an enrolment fee of \$30.00 per child, per sacrament, which helps cover the costs of programme materials for each Sacrament.
- **Enrolment Deadline:** It is essential for all children to be enrolled before the closing date. Enrolments cannot be accepted after the closing date.
- **Compulsory Attendance:** Attendance is mandatory for both the child and parent/guardian at all four sessions of the preparation programme to ensure proper preparation for receiving the Sacrament.
- **Baptism Certificate Requirement:** If this is your child's first Sacrament at Our Lady of the Rosary, The Entrance, and they were not baptised here, a copy of the child's Baptism certificate must be provided at the time of enrolment. Additional documentation may be required for other Sacraments not received in our parish.

Structure of the Programme

The order of reception of the Sacraments in the Diocese of Broken Bay is Baptism, Confirmation, Reconciliation and Eucharist (First Communion). Please contact us if you have any questions regarding this order.

The Sacramental preparation program in our parish, and indeed throughout the Diocese of Broken Bay, is a parish based and family centred process. It is structured in a way for parents/guardians and their child to work through the booklet together as part of a parish sacramental group under the guidance of a group leader, and are encouraged to continue the discussion and exercises at home. Both parish and family play an important role in journeying with the children towards full initiation into the Church.

If you are unable to attend one of the four sessions you must contact me as soon as possible. I will then be able to advise you on how best to complete the missed session to suit your circumstances. All 4 sessions must be completed to be eligible to receive the Sacrament.
