The Confirmation sponsor:

Godparents are the ideal sponsor if they are available, but any Catholic, Baptised person who is 16 years or older and has received the Sacraments of Confirmation and Holy Communion may be a sponsor. Only one sponsor is permitted for each child. Parents cannot be their own child's sponsor.

Important Information for Enrolment in the Sacramental Programme

- Expressions of Interest: can be completed online. However, to finalise the enrolment process, parents or guardians are required to attend one of the three scheduled information sessions. During these sessions, important details about the current Sacrament will be discussed and only then will the children be enrolled accordingly. At these sessions, the workbook can be collected along with other instructions. Please note that children do not need to attend these sessions.
- Enrolment Fee: There is an enrolment fee of \$30.00 per child, which helps cover the costs of programme materials for each Sacrament. Payment can be made in cash or via EFTPOS during the Information and Enrolment session. If paying by cash, it is helpful to have the correct amount. If financial difficulties arise, please to speak with Fr. Brian or Colleen Smith for assistance.
- Enrolment Deadline: It is essential for all children to be enrolled at least one week before the commencement of lessons. Additionally, a parent or guardian must have attended an information session or had a meeting with a member of the clergy before the deadline date.
- **Compulsory Attendance:** Attendance is mandatory for both the child and parent/guardian at all four sessions of the preparation programme to ensure proper preparation for receiving the Sacrament.
- Baptism Certificate Requirement: If this is your child's first Sacrament at Our Lady of the Rosary, The Entrance, and they were not baptised here, a copy of the child's Baptism certificate must be provided at the time of enrolment. Additional documentation may be required for other Sacraments not received in our parish.
- Encouragement for Mass Attendance: As part of the Sacramental Programme, parents and guardians are encouraged to attend weekend Masses with their children. Children will be presented during designated parish weekend Masses throughout the preparation period leading up to receiving the Sacrament.
- Location of Events: All events will take place at the parish precinct unless stated otherwise.

Thank you for your attention to these details. We look forward to supporting you and your child through this important process.

Structure of the Programme

The order of reception of the Sacraments in the Diocese of Broken Bay is Baptism, Confirmation, Reconciliation and Eucharist (First Communion).

The Sacramental preparation program in our parish, and indeed throughout the Diocese of Broken Bay, is a parish based and family centred process. It is structured in a way for parents/guardians and their child to work through the booklet together as part of a parish sacramental group under the guidance of a group leader, and are encouraged to continue the discussion and exercises at home. Both parish and family play an important role in journeying with the children towards full initiation into the Church.

If you are unable to attend one of the four sessions <u>you</u> <u>must</u> contact me as soon as possible. I will then be able to advise you on how best to complete the missed session to suit your circumstances. All 4 sessions must be completed to be eligible to receive the Sacrament.
