The Confirmation sponsor:

Godparents are a great sponsor if they are available but any Catholic, baptised person who is 16 years or older and has received the Sacraments of Confirmation and Holy Communion may be a sponsor. Only one sponsor is permitted for each child. Parents cannot be their own child's sponsor.

Important Information for Each Sacrament

- Enrolment will be at the Information evenings. At these evenings parents/guardians will be able to enroll their child to prepare for the current Sacrament and meet with the Parish Priest and Sacramental team. If you are unable to attend this evening, you will be required to phone the parish office to make an appointment with a member of the Sacramental team <u>before</u> the close of the enrolment date.
- An Enrolment Fee of \$25.00 per child is required to help cover the cost of the programme materials for each Sacrament. This fee can be paid in cash or by EFTPOS on the Information and Enrolment night. If, however, you have any difficulties in paying this fee please don't hesitate to speak with Fr Brian or Colleen Smith.
- All children must be enrolled one week <u>before</u>
 lessons commence and the parent must have met
 with a member of the Sacramental team if unable
 to attend information and enrolment night.
- At least one parent, or legal guardian, must attend the Information & Enrolment evening or meet with a member of the Sacramental team to enrol the child. Children are not required to attend.
- Attendance at all 4 sessions of the programme is compulsory for both child and parent/guardian to adequately prepare the child to receive the Sacrament.
- If this is your child's first Sacrament here in the parish of Our Lady of the Rosary, The Entrance and the child was not baptised here, a copy of the child's Baptism certificate is to be provided at the time of enrolment.
- Children will be presented at parish weekend Masses during the preparation time before receiving the Sacrament, so we encourage families to attend weekend masses.
- All events will be held at the parish precinct unless otherwise advised.

Structure of the Programme

The order of reception of the Sacraments in the Diocese of Broken Bay is Baptism, Confirmation, Reconciliation and Eucharist (First Communion).

The Sacramental preparation program in our parish, and indeed throughout the Diocese of Broken Bay, is a parish based and family centred process. It is structured in a way for parents and their child to work through the booklet together as part of a parish sacramental group under the guidance of a group leader, and to continue the discussion and exercises at home. Both parish and family play an important role in journeying with the children towards full initiation into the Church.

Parents <u>must</u> contact the Parish Sacramental Coordinator if they miss a session as all 4 sessions must be completed to be eligible to receive the Sacrament. The Sacramental Coordinator will be able to advise on how best to complete the missed session.
