### **Information for parents:**

Thank you for giving your child the opportunity to serve. There is no cost involved in your child becoming an Altar Server. Training will generally involve one session after school (until 4.30pm).

Those rostered to serve are listed in the Parish Bulletin one week in advance of their duty. Your child will be rostered the same weekend per month, i.e. first to fifth weekend of the month. Please ensure your child arrives at the Church 15 minutes before the scheduled start of Mass.

Servers are not to have open toed footwear in the interest of health and safety (possible contact with hot wax). Servers will only need to stay 10 minutes after Mass concludes.
