From Fr David

Dear friends,

We warmly welcome Fr Marek Woldan into our parish family this weekend as our new Assistant Priest. Fr Marek comes to us with rich pastoral experience both in his native Poland and in Papua New Guinea where he ministered in the Diocese of Mendi for a good number of years. I am sure that you will make him most welcome!

Regretfully, we welcome Fr Marek into some chaos in our residence on 100 Archer Street, given that the renovations are now in full swing. We are making good progress, though inevitably these things take time. We have a wonderful builder who has been able to coordinate the various tradesmen in quite the exceptional way. So far: the asbestos on the property has all been removed; the ceiling and roof have been reinforced; the ceiling of the front verandah has been replaced; the casing of the bulkhead in the kitchen has been repaired; central air conditioning has been installed throughout the entire house; lighting and electrical sockets have been upgraded; the windows/doors across the front of the house have both been replaced with sound reduction glass; two of the bathrooms have been completely guttered and rebuilt; and the painting of the interior has commenced. The windows are all still to be repaired, some new internal doors are to be fitted, the external guttering is to be replaced, and a new garage door is to be installed. All of this will ensure that the residence is a fitting place for the clergy and that the asset will have been both protected and increased in value.

A very special thank you to Gillian Hawkins and the extraordinary team of people who conduct our Bunnings BBQs. These ventures are for the support of StreetWorks here in Chatswood. Over the last two BBQs, \$3,453.40 has been raised! This is a mighty effort and everyone involved is rightly proud. Thank you to everyone who comes together to make these occasions so successful. Their generosity has a direct influence on benefiting the lives of others. This too is the aspiration of our Community Action. Last Tuesday, with Sydney Alliance our Community Action team held an online forum with candidates standing for election in the Ku-ring-gai Council on the issue of housing affordability. It was a very informative and important opportunity for our social engagement around an important issue that, left unattended, erodes our capacity for community and the wellbeing of people.

Also, our gratitude to all those who worked as hard to make our church look so special for our inaugural Red Wednesday Mass last week. It truly was spectacular. This is the occasion for us to be mindful of the Church suffering in so many parts of the world and we look forward now to making this an annual event.



Though the NSW Assembly has now taken its vote on the Voluntary Assisted Dying legislation it is not too late to make our voice known in defense of life. Please do sign the petitions available in the foyer of the church.

Next weekend, 4-5 December we celebrate the Sacrament of Confirmation for our children who had prepared for the celebration prior to the recent lockdown. We will have liturgies on Saturday 4 December at 11am, 12.30pm and 2.00pm, and then again on Sunday 5 December with our 9am Mass and at 2.00pm.

We have now begun a new liturgical year! A very special thank you to all those who are working in the background to make this year's celebration particularly festive. Available in our church are brochures with all the details! So, do be sure to take one and join us on one of the many occasions of celebration. This Sunday evening, we have one of two Advent online seminars. And from Monday morning we will recommence Morning Prayer each day at 8.45am prior to our celebration of Mass at 9.00am.


This Christmas let's follow Mary's example of saying 'Yes' to God. The following is one way you might respond with your Yes.
