### PARISH PASTORAL & MISSIONARY COUNCIL - meeting summary.

The PPMC met for its final meeting of 2021 at 7.30pm on Tuesday 30th November in the parish's Magnificat meeting room. We welcomed Fr Marek Woldan, our new Assistant Priest to the parish. And we also said a warm thank you to Gail Gill who is stepping down from the PPMC after five years of service. Thankfully Gail is not going far and will still be serving in the parish team.

Following a prayer on the coming of our Lord, we continued to reflect on Fratelli tutti, this time on an extract of Chapter 8 - Religions at the Service of Fraternity in our World. In this, pope Francis confirms the wellspring of human dignity and fraternity is in the Gospel of Jesus Christ. This led to discussions on ecumenism, as well as our reflection on our vocation on Christian thought, action of the Church, the primacy given to relationship and universal communion with the entire human family.

Drawing on discussions from preceding meetings throughout the year, we explored the opportunity to deepen our journeying together in Christ as a parish. Brendan presented a proposal for our journey being a Church in the city (a reference from Fr David's pastoral letter, Pentecost 2021). What do we dream/desire our parish to be? This is a question for all of us, and as we emerge from this pandemic crisis, and step into the parish's second century, the parish has the opportunity to prepare for this journey with the aim of launching an agreed plan at Pentecost 2023. There is much work to be done, including understanding our parish today, conversing and agreeing on our mission as a parish and deciding a direction and our approach. Plans are underway on how to facilitate this discussion and involvement with the whole parish. This plan includes the forming of a project team that will help coordinate key activities and key communications over the coming 18 months.

Christmas preparations are underway, and wonderful events have been planned leading up to Christmas. Parish volunteers have been busy organising several events this Christmas such as the Christmas video; Annual Christmas Bake Sale Fundraiser (12 Dec); Eat, Pray and Chill (9,16,23 Dec); and Candlelight Carols (18 Dec).
