

Dear Parishioners,

Fr Jim and Fr Bogdan will be away at Wyong with all the clergy of the diocese on their annual conference from June 14-18. Masses on Monday at 9.30am and Friday 12.15pm will be celebrated as usual. Masses on Tuesday at 12.15pm, Wednesday 9.30am, Thursday 9.30am & 12.15pm and Friday 9.30am will be replaced by a Liturgy of the Word with Holy Communion. There will be no healing Mass or Liturgy on Wednesday at 9.15am or 10am, and no Adoration and Reconciliation on Monday night. We apologise for the inconvenience, and are grateful to the parishioners who are leading the Liturgies in our absence – Fr Jim and Fr Bogdan.

New Mass time: From Wednesday June 23rd there will be Mass at 6pm at OLHC, replacing 9.15am Mass. We hope that this will allow people who work during the day to have access to a weekday Mass. It will also serve as a trial to see how we might find alternative Mass times when there is construction at the OLHC site next year. The monthly healing Mass at 10am will continue from July 21st in addition to the 6pm Mass. 9.30am Mass at St Gerard's will continue as usual.

The Catholic Cemeteries Trust manages Catholic cemeteries throughout NSW, including North Rocks Cemetery. The NSW Govt wants to abolish the Trust and centralise management of all cemeteries, which may lead to the cost of graves rising. Please consider signing this petition at https://saveourgraves.com.au/ which is being promoted by Sydney Archdiocese. Present media coverage suggests that the Government is starting to listen to the Church's concerns, but additional support from concerned Catholics will be important to hold the Govt to account.

Confirmation: The sacrament of Confirmation has had varied approaches in different times and places. Since the earliest years of the Church it was the confirming by the bishop of baptism which had been given by a priest or deacon. Even when baptism began to include infants, Confirmation, and then Communion were sacraments of initiation given to older children and adolescents. In the early 20th century Pope Pius X reduced the age of first Communion to seven or eight, but left Confirmation at age twelve or older. This is what many of us would have experienced as children, making it seem normal, when in fact it was a change from the longer tradition of the Church. In recent decades some dioceses, including ours have sought to restore the original order, moving Confirmation earlier so that it again becomes the confirming of baptism, before other sacraments are received. A frequently expressed concern was that seven year old children couldn't understand the sacrament. While this may well be true, twelve year old's didn't fully understand it either. The focus is on the child receiving a sacrament which they can grow into. This year Bishop Anthony has pushed Confirmation back one year, so that children will now receive it from Year 3 onwards, and Reconciliation and Communion will follow in Year 4 onwards. The normal sequence of sacraments then will be baptism - confirmation - reconciliation - eucharist.

Jesuit Refugee Service Australia would like to thank you for your thoughtful donation to our foodbank over the past 6 weeks. In 2020, the COVID-19 pandemic brought immense hardship to all members of Australian society. For refugees, people seeking asylum, and migrants in vulnerable situations, this hardship was amplified to a significantly greater degree.

Volunteers: Thank you to the more than 60 people who recently volunteered for new ministries, many of whom volunteered for more than one. Your details have been given to the leaders of ministries and they will contact you in the coming week or two.

Why does recycling matter to Catholics? In his encyclical Laudato 'Si Pope Francis calls us to care for our common home, planet earth. He shows us a new approach to why production and consumption matters: because all of the earth is God's beloved creation. He laments that "the earth, our home, is beginning to look more and more like an immense pile of filth" (LS 21) and that "these problems are closely linked to a throwaway culture which affects the excluded just as it quickly reduces things to rubbish" (LS 22). Throughout the letter he shows that a society which respects the dignity of the human person will also respect the natural environment, and that conversely a society which is quick to discard things as useless once they fall out of fashion is also quick to discard the disabled, the elderly and the unborn when they become inconvenient. So recycling, repairing, refusing, re-purposing and reusing is part of our stewardship of creation, and also of building a just society. Fr Jim and Hien recently delivered some non-working electronics to Arnie's Recon which did a collection in North Epping. They're a great alternative to kerbside collections which go to landfill. This was arranged by a local group including parishioner Kathy Bradford called *Move It On.* You can find them on facebook. Also see https://www.arniesrecon.com/. There will be another collection on 27/6 for ewaste (no fridges or freezers), household batteries, polystyrene, light globes and flouro tubes, makeup (arranged by Makeup for Mecca).

We always like to hear from you and look forward to building a fruitful relationship. If you have any queries or would like to see what our parish has to offer your family and your children, please feel free to contact me.



Parish - Understanding Parish Collections

As we draw towards the end of the current financial year, I would like to thank everybody for their generosity in contributing to the parish collections by various methods.

The undermentioned may help clarify what each collection is used for:

The First Collection

Money collected from the first collection supports the needs of priests of the parish.

- The priests' monthly salary.
- Upkeep of the presbytery, e.g., food, utilities, cleaner, etc.
- A small percentage to cover the expenses of the Bishop in caring for elderly priests.

Income from other sources includes Easter and Christmas offerings (via envelope contributions made at these times. Wedding and baptism donations are also added into the final collection.

The Second Collection

Money from the second collection supports the maintenance of the parish buildings and pastoral programs. The parish must work within its own budget and is unable to draw funds for expenses from any source other than its own parish income. Loans for church works are permitted as long as they can be serviced.

Some of the expenses covered are:

- Parish running costs, e.g. administration, insurance, utilities, general maintenance and upkeep of the Church, presbytery and parish property.
- Parish staff salaries including superannuation.
- Priests' car expenses.
- Charitable Works Fund shortfall. (if we don't reach our quota for the appeal, then the difference is paid out of Church funds).

The Collection combines income from planned giving envelopes, credit cards, direct debits and cash in the boxes.

Special Collections

- The Charitable Works Fund (CWF) supports CatholicCare, CCD (ministry expenses for Catechists in state schools), Ephpheta Centre, Aboriginal Catholic Ministry, Seminaries and Chaplaincies, etc.
- The priests' Retirement Foundation, supports sick and retired priests.
- The Holy Places annual collection is for the Church in the Holy Land.
- Peter's Pence (Holy Father's Appeal) is a collection for intentions of the Holy Father.
- Project Compassion Appeal held in Lent supports the charitable works of Caritas Australia in developing countries.
- Catholic Mission's focus is on the Church's worldwide missionary activities.
- The Society of St Vincent de Paul, Winter and Christmas Appeals provide assistance to society's needy and disadvantaged persons.
