Dear Parishioners,

Endings and New Beginnings

The end of this year sees a number of people stepping down from significant positions of leadership and service in our parish.

Maree Balzulat has tendered her resignation from both her paid and voluntary roles as Assistant Parish Secretary after 18 years. Maree has given extraordinarily generous and dedicated service to our parishioners and ministry groups over these years. She will conclude her role at the end of February to begin her retirement at which time we will endeavour to farewell and thank her appropriately.

Mary O'Byrne is stepping down from her role of Secondary Schools Catechist Coordinator after 8 years. Mary has led and driven this ministry of proclaiming Christ's good news in Cheltenham High, James Ruse High and Carlingford High which is an extraordinary feat given that more and more Catholic parishes have no ministry to high schools at all. The secondary catechists will be thanking her at a lunch on Nov 25th.

Gordon Floyd has given his resignation from the Parish Finance Committee. Gordon has been a foundation member of the PFC, and also, together with Margaret, foundation members of St Gerard's. The first meeting to plan to build St Gerard's Church was held in their home. Gordon has served the parish faithfully for more than 50 years.

Bob Crane has given his resignation from the Parish Finance Committee and from his voluntary role of maintenance coordinator for the parish. Bob has also served the parish for nearly 50 years both in hands on maintenance for the parish and OLHC School, and behind the scenes work. Bob has served the parish in an extraordinary way. The Parish Finance Committee will thank Gordon and Bob at a dinner later this month.

The coinciding of each of these resignations, along with the upcoming redevelopment at Epping may prompt a concern that so much is changing and that we are 'losing' these good people. But each of them has built up the life of the parish, and now, there is the opportunity for others to build on their work. Lynn Siau will now take up the communications component of Maree's role (website, bulletin, social

media and signage). Information for the bulletin can be directed to Lynn from Jan 1st.

I am creating a new staff role called "Operations Coordinator" which will take on other aspects of Maree's work, shared with Dennis Porteous, and which will include the maintenance coordination which Bob Crane had previously done. The full role description and position details are in this bulletin. While we will advertise more widely it will be a role well suited to a parishioner who already knows the context of the parish. It will have opportunity for flexible hours which may be attractive to parents with school aged children.

In consultation with the Pastoral Council Fr Bogdan and I have begun creating several new voluntary leadership roles such as coordinators for each of the liturgical ministries at both churches. There will be several new roles and teams created in the coming months to take over some of the ministry support work which Maree has been doing.

While Katherine Tam will continue to coordinate the primary school catechists, the position of secondary catechist coordinator is now vacant. Fr Jim and the parish team will work to ensure that the catechists are supported until another coordinator emerges.

The resignation of four PFC members (Bob Crane and Gordon Floyd, as well as John Waddell and Giang Pham) creates space for new people to step up into leadership on the Parish Finance Committee. We now have fixed 3 year terms, so we won't see the likes of Gordon & Bob's extraordinary long service again, but hopefully this becomes a manageable possibility for people.

The work of the PFC will be vital in these next few years as we determine how best to use the new buildings at Epping and the income which it will provide. The role of the Pastoral Council will also be invaluable in guiding us through these years of transition and shaping the vision for the faith life of the parish.

While beginning this season of farewells I also mention that Hien Vu will complete his year on pastoral placement with us at Christmas before returning to the seminary for his final two years of formation. We will farewell Hien at the Christmas carols event on Boxing Day night. Richard Houwing is due to complete his pastoral placement as a diaconate aspirant at the end of the year also, but may stay for a few additional months to offset the time missed in lockdown.

So there are significant changes afoot, and with these come significant opportunities for the Holy Spirit to continue to work in and through us to guide us to become the church which God wants us to be. I invite you to prayerfully consider if you might be available to serve in any of these roles.

Covid Restrictions updates: As of Nov 8th our density limit in our churches and meeting rooms is now 2 sqm per person. We encourage you to continue to keep 1.5m physical distancing where possible.

While the NSW Govt now allows singing by vaccinated people the diocese has recommended that we continue to discourage congregational singing for the time being.

Face masks continue to be mandatory indoors until Dec 15th or 95% vaccinated. Until this time eating, drinking and singing will need to be done outside of our parish meeting rooms.

We can now have, junior servers within Mass, and offertory processions and gospel processions.

Air Conditioning: The new air conditioning at St Gerard's is nearing completion. It comes at a substantial cost of nearly \$200,000 due to the design constraints which required a custom-built system.

We will be holding the Sale in the Old School Building and it will be open after the Sunday morning Masses.

Come one & all to celebrate the amazing work our Catechists (SRE Teachers) do in the 9 State Schools across our Parish.


Take this opportunity to thank, support and discover what these very busy people do for us at the **9.30am Mass** on **21 November at St Gerard's**.
