Every year we celebrate the good news of Jesus' birth, but this year, perhaps more than ever, we need the hope and joy which Jesus brings into our world. We invite you to recapture the hope of one small child whose birth 2000 years ago brought Heaven to touch Earth and whose life and love are still with us today. It has been our privilege to be your pastors this year through good, the bad and the changing times which a pandemic, lockdown, and

re-opening have brought. No matter what 2022 may bring, we invite you to journey with our parish community where we seek to find God in in every part of our lives. The

opportunities which these pages contain are our invitation to you, on behalf of our whole parish team, to come and be part of our parish family next year. May God bless you – Fr Jim McKeon & Fr Bogdan Skupien.

New Youth-Led Mass: We're launching a new youth-led Mass at St Gerard's on Sunday nights at 5pm starting January 30th. While everyone is welcome, it will be our teenagers and young adults who will be taking the lead in our ministries. We'll offer a BBQ or other hospitality afterwards, and then our Antioch youth group for people aged 16-23 follows.

Gathering online: One thing we discovered this year was that when we can't gather in person that online gatherings can be very effective, whether that is a gathering for work, with family, with friends, or as a church. During lockdown we gathered on Sunday evenings for a liturgy of prayer, scripture and sharing. And even though lockdown is now behind us, we know that coming to church can be challenging whether that's due to having a baby or a toddler, or being housebound through illness or injury or caring for someone. For others, just coming into a crowded church can be a bit unfamiliar or intimidating. So I'd now like to invite you to something new which we created during lockdown: a monthly, online liturgy gathering for families with

young children which we're calling "Toe in the Water" (as in, a gentle way to ease into a Sunday church gathering).





We'll meet on the 4th Sunday afternoon of each month at 4.30pm starting January 23rd. We'll listen to a bible reading, reflect on moments of joy in our lives, have music, and pray together. You and your children can take part from the comfort of your couch, and even crying toddlers or barking pets are welcome. It will run on Zoom via the QR code here.

The Epping Redevelopment: Planning has been underway for several years now in partnership with Stockland to redevelop the OLHC site to build a new Parish Centre (hall, meeting rooms and offices), and school with underground parking and outdoor gathering spaces centred around OLHC Church. The Parish will handover control of the site to Stockland on February 4th for redevelopment to commence. There are posters at the back of OLHC Church, and visuals at ttps://olhc-develop.com.au/designplans/ to show you what is planned. OLHC Church will always remain open and accessible on weekends for Mass. We will explore our options for parking and for weekday Masses early in the new year.

Christmas & New Year changes: All of our Masses & Reconciliation times will continue, with the only exception being no adoration & reconciliation on Monday Jan. 3rd at OLHC. The Parish Office will be closed from Christmas Day to Monday January 3rd but the office number 9876 2853 will divert to one of the priest's phones at all times. Fr Jim will be on annual leave from Dec 30th to January 10th.

Mass for New Year's Eve: Fr Bogdan will celebrate a special Mass at 6pm at St Gerard's on Friday Dec 31st as a vigil of the Solemnity of the Mother of God and to pray for the new year ahead. This will be in place of adoration that evening. New Year's Day Mass will be the usual Saturday time of 9.15am at OLHC with the blessings of Images of Our Lady.

Welcome back to Fr Anselam Lakra who will be celebrating Masses at St Gerard's on Jan 1st and 2nd, and to Fr Joey Frez who will be celebrating Masses at OLHC on Jan 8th & 9th while Fr Jim is away.

Hien has taken part in almost every area of parish life, and brough his gentle, engaging, welcoming presence to everything he has done.
