Dear Parishioners,

**Almsgiving:** During Lent we focus on three practices: Fasting, Prayer and Almsgiving. In recent weeks our bulletin has offered a number opportunity for prayer, and a reflection on contemporary approaches to fasting. This week we invite you to consider almsgiving, that is, charitable giving. This is something most of us already do, whether that is the weekly parish collections, the various other charities and appeals run through the parish each year, or other charities which you might also support. This weekend a member of our Parish Finance Committee will report to you on your generosity to the parish in the financial year 2019-2020.

I invite you to reflect on how your giving is an act of worship and of your discipleship. Jesus' praise of the poor widow (Mark 12:41) shows how it is the intentionality of giving, not just the amount and its effect which are virtuous. During Lent I invite you to see the giving you are already doing in this way

**QR codes, bookings and signing in:** Did you know that by law we are required to have an electronic copy of the contact details of each person who comes into our church? While cafes and restaurants are required to use the Service NSW QR code, the government allowed churches the option of letting people sign in by hand, as long as these details were then immediately typed up. As you can imagine this is a lot of work! Moving to booking online will greatly reduce this workload, but for weekdays we also ask you to scan in using the Service NSW QR code (now available at both churches) in preference to signing in whenever you can.

**Easter Liturgy Times:** We can now confirm that our Easter liturgies will be at the same times as previous years, with the addition of an Easter Vigil at OLHC at 7pm, and a Sunday night Mass at OLHC at 6pm. This is so that we can offer as many people as possible the opportunity to come Mass despite the restrictions on numbers.

People involved in liturgical ministries will be receiving invitations to serve at these liturgies in the coming week.

**Re-engagement**: Easter is a wonderful opportunity for us to re-engage with the many people who may have fallen away from church involvement during 2020, and not yet returned. We have a three pronged strategy.

- Invite. We're going to letterbox drop every dwelling in the parish with an invitation to Easter and we need your help to deliver these to your neighbours. On the weekend of March 21<sup>st</sup> we will be asking you to take a bunch of postcards for St Gerard's or flyers for OLHC and deliver them to a street near you.
- 2. Welcome. Our rostered greeters will be ready at the door, but welcoming begins in the carpark, continues as we walk up to the church, and extends through after Mass. Each of us can be the welcoming face of the parish, and therefore of Christ, to people as they return to Mass, perhaps after a long hiatus. Practice saying hello to strangers this weekend!
- Engage. Once people have come into the church we want to engage them in worship, despite whatever restrictions may still be in place. Our ministers, especially music ministers are already preparing.


Please pray for, and take part in this strategy so that we can rebuild our parish, post-Covid, even better than it was before.

# **Culture of Giving**

In years past parishes could rely on the cash given on the collection plate at Sunday Mass to provide for all the needs of the parish. Last year's COVID disruption meant that while parish expenses for maintenance, utilities and wages continued the parish lost much of its cash income. Many people however generously moved to regular forms of cashless giving, either by electronic funds transfer or by credit card. This generosity was remarkable and allowed the parish to continue to operate with only a modest deficit. As we look forward to the time when our churches can again be full we hope that people will continue to give in these electronic ways, and that others will join them. Giving electronically reduces the risk and cost of cash handling, and it gives the parish a reliable income from which we can budget to spend wisely. Arranging your own regular giving allows you to plan for your generosity to the parish as part of your personal budget setting. As a new parishioner myself, I've joined the planned giving program, giving monthly by credit card — Fr Jim.

# Financial Report for the Year Ended 30 June 2020

The last quarter of the year was severely impacted by COVID. On the income side, we received a JobKeeper subsidy of \$30,000 and a Cash Flow Boost of \$22,810 from the government, which helped us maintain our planned revenues. On the expenses side, we were able to reduce some of our costs as the churches were closed. Overall, the Parish made a net loss of \$20,836.



### **Explanatory Notes**

- (1) The JobKeeper and Cash Flow Boost were provided by the government to support organisations during COVID. The JobKeeper was a subsidy that was paid to staff.
- (2) Maintenance and capital expenses during the year included replacing rusting steel windows and upgrading our stormwater drainage. Some expenses in the 6 months to December 2020 include priority items from the 10 Year Maintenance Plan for the Carlingford church and presbytery. A major project being considered is the upgrade of the air conditioning system in Carlingford church which is 25 years old and no longer working efficiently. The cost is about \$300,000 and a fundraising appeal is planned.
- (3) Pastoral Activities is net of money received from those participating in the programmes. Gross expenses on activities amounted to \$24,521, split as follows:
