

FIRST EUCHARIST 2025

We are approaching the final preparations for the children, readying their hearts to receive our Lord for the first time. There have been many thoughts from them on the true presence of Jesus in the bread and wine. The children have learnt a big word: **Transubstantiation**.

"Huh? What does that mean?" followed by attempts to say it.

"Trans means to change. Substance is the very essence of a thing. So the bread and wine has become the Body and Blood of Christ, but because the taste and appearance does not change, you can't tell that they have changed. By the power of the Holy Spirit from the priest's prayers, Jesus has come to us in such a special way. Everytime you receive Holy Communion, you take a piece of Jesus within you, the bread that transubstantiated into Jesus."

"Wow, is that why some Saints sacrificed themselves to protect the bread?"


