FROM OUR PARISH PRIEST - FR JIM MCKEON



Investment: You will recall last year I advised the parish that we were scheduled to receive an amount of money as a result of the Epping Development, it is important that we continue to keep you informed as to what is happening with these funds. \$2million dollars has been invested under the guidance of Morgan Stanley, the advisers to the Diocese of Broken Bay, who are one of the world's largest private wealth management organisations.

The Diocese has adopted an Investment Policy Statement which is based on economic and financial factors within an ethical framework. Investments must be guided by Catholic Social Teaching and the

ethical principles of the Catholic Church. The guidelines introduce investment constraints to the investable universe of securities which may generate investment returns and risks that are potentially different to investing in an unconstrained investment universe.

Many of you would be only too familiar with the prevailing economic circumstances both in Australia and overseas over the last twelve months or so and the investment for the parish has in turn been affected by these difficulties. It is important to understand that the decision to invest has adopted the parameters of a three to five year time frame and it is therefore important to always remember never to assess performance, neither negative of positive, over a short period of time.

The investment's primary focus is the derivation of income and therefore traditionally concentrates on conservative areas of cash and fixed interest with a lesser allocation to the growth investment areas of shares and property. The investment was effectively made in January 2023 and the balance as at June 30th sits at \$2,016,814. There is very little if any income generated from the investment thus far.

Our parish income has and always will predominantly depend on the continuing generosity of both past and current parishioners through the planned giving program of the parish. The income you provide us allows the parish budget to meet many commitments such as faith development programmes, employment of additional staff, youth programmes, parish functions and ongoing maintenance of our churches.

As was stated last year, the Planned Giving program is a wonderful way to grow in faith and support your parish. Our growth in faith happens when we give generously and enthusiastically. This helps us grow in our understanding that all we have is a gift from God. We simply administer our money and possessions for God's good. In giving we show that God and not money is our priority in life.
