
The commencement of various parish activities has also seen an increase in the booking of rooms. The following rooms at OLHC are currently listed for use:

#### **PARISH SOCIAL JUSTICE**



**The Challenge of Pope Leo XIV:** Our new Pope has chosen his name as a successor of Pope Leo XIII, whose groundbreaking encyclical *Rerum Novarum* launched a new field of Catholic Social Teaching in 1891. *Rerum Novarum* presented the Church's alternative solution to Marxism for the relationship between labourers and capitalists, and stressed the dignity of the worker, the right to form trade unions, the right to just wages, and the right to own private property tempered by the realization that

property is to be used for the good of all humanity, not just the few. Successive Popes have built on *Rerum Novarum* and on the Church's role in promoting a just society for all.

It is fitting then that we as a parish (along with Chatswood Parish, Sydney & Parramatta Dioceses and the St Vincent de Paul Society are members of the Sydney Alliance, a coalition of faith and non-faith groups working for the common good in areas such as just wages, affordable housing, clean and affordable energy and accessible public transport. We're hosting two-day training workshops at **OLHC on Saturday May 24<sup>th</sup> and 31<sup>st</sup>** to build our skills in advocacy for the common good. 
